LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT

THIS LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT made and entered into on the ______ of _____, 2018 by and between the Trigg County Board of Education (the "District") and the City of Cadiz Police Department (the "CPD");

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the District and the CPD have previously entered into contractual agreements whereby the CPD provides law enforcement officers unto the District; and

WHEREAS, the District and the CPD wish to continue their partnership whereby the CPD will furnish law enforcement officials unto the District under the terms and conditions later set out herein; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to reduce to writing their agreement concerning the foregoing;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

<u>TERM:</u> The effective date of this agreement shall be July 1, 2018 and continue through June 30, 2019 subject to renewals later defined herein.

<u>LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES:</u> The CPD shall provide the District with two (2) sworn law enforcement officers for the position of School Resource Officer (hereinafter, "SRO") to provide security and law enforcement services at such site or sites designated by the District among Trigg County Public Schools.

<u>COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES</u>: In consideration of the services provided the District by the CPD, as described in this agreement, the District shall reimburse the CPD the sum of the salaries for the SRO's and shall pay an annual equipment lease of \$5,000, payable in four (4) quarterly installments.

Vehicles, Equipment, and Uniforms: The CPD shall provide police vehicles, uniforms, and necessary equipment (i.e, weapon, handcuffs, tazor) that is required in the performance of their duties.

<u>EMPLOYEE STATUS</u>: All law enforcement personnel provided the District pursuant to this contract shall be the exclusive employees of the CPD, and the CPD shall be solely responsible for workers compensation benefits, and, primarily liable for law enforcement liability insurance coverage.

<u>PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT & TRAINING</u>: All law enforcement personnel provided to the District shall be properly trained as a SRO. Ongoing professional development and training shall be the responsibility of the CPD. The CPD will maintain training records and ensure all necessary training is provided to the officer(s).

<u>SRO SUPERVISION AND DUTIES:</u> All SROs shall be under the direct supervision of the Chief of Police for the CPD or his designee. However, the Chief of Police and Superintendent or their respective designees will collaborate on the appropriate duties for the SRO's.

SRO's are to be on school campus during all instructional time. SRO's shall notify the Director of Student Services and Personnel if the SRO will not be present on a given

day. However, it is understood that officers may be required to attend court or other duty. In those cases, CPD will consult with the Director of Student Services and Personnel to have a replacement officer on duty at the designated schools. All SRO's will have lunch on school campus to be available at all times.

<u>RENEWAL OF CONTRACT</u>: This contract shall continue to automatically renew itself for additional one (1) year terms at the conclusion of the then expiring one year term unless either party gives forty-five (45) days written notice unto the other of its intent not to renew same. Any automatic renewal of this contract shall be under the same terms and conditions as previously set out. Any proposed changes by either party should be presented in writing before the automatic renewal date and, if accepted, would constitute a new agreement.
