



Founded in 2008, Magnified Giving (www.magnifiedgiving.org) is an established Philanthropy Education organization based in Cincinnati, touching the lives of over 19,000 students since our inception. To date, those students of Magnified Giving have granted over \$704,000 to local non-profit organizations. Specifically the results of the dedication during 2017-18 school year produced: 149 grants awarded to local Non-Profits, over \$161,000.00 awarded with \$24,332.00 of that raised by students and their encouraging community! Everyone enjoyed a successful year and we are fully aware it is due to the amazing leadership of your facilitators within your school!

2019-2018 Principal Support Agreement

To help us continue to partner with the leadership at your school, we ask school principals to be aware of our program and to show their support of their facilitator's involvement.

I am aware that my school has applied to participate in the Magnified Giving Student Philanthropy program under the guidance of a lead facilitator.

I am aware that he/she will guide the group of students through program steps found on the Magnified Giving website (www.magnifiedgiving.org/steps).

I am aware that our students will be learning about philanthropy, exploring the social needs of our community, identifying and contacting the 501(C)(3) non-profit organizations that address those needs, possibly visiting non-profit organizations, volunteering their time, making difficult decisions in selecting an organization that will utilize the funds awarded in the best way possible, fundraising (if determined by the facilitator), and that student representatives will be asked to attend an Awards Ceremony to present their checks(s) during the school year.

I am aware that our students will be entrusted to "invest" \$1000 of Magnified Giving's money by choosing a local non-profit organization to receive our school's grant, and our students can earn more money to invest by participating in student fundraising. (Magnified Giving will match up to \$250 of student-raised funds.)

I am aware that we may have guest speakers visit our school – Magnified Giving's founder Roger Grein, agency representatives, and possibly other guests as selected by the lead facilitator.

I am aware that all student participants must register with Magnified Giving at the start of the program via an online form on Magnified Giving's website. This will allow Magnified Giving to track the success of our program, to allow students to stay connected to Magnified Giving through our Alumni Association, and to expand the reach of the program around the region. Magnified Giving will gather basic student information (name, email address, phone number) and parent information (name, email address, phone number). This information is for internal use only and will not be shared with outside organizations. **We will not solicit donations from students or parents.**

Also, for schools utilizing **FINAL FORMS or other programs similar** we would like to request Magnified Giving is included in the list of Extra-Curricular Activities offered. The facilitators are fantastic about sharing the successes of their programs via stories, student quotes about their experience, video and photos. If we are able to be included on **your registration site** this will eliminate addition work on the facilitator attempting to receive parental release for Magnified Giving to share the good news. Our goal is to celebrate the schools and the amazing work taking place within your community!

I am aware that our lead facilitator will be asked to attend a Facilitator Training session in September 2018, complete periodic updates, attend an Awards Ceremony during the school year along with student participants, and will be required to complete a Final Report in June 2019. Please note, you are welcome to attend the Facilitator Training if you'd like to learn more about the curriculum.

For his/her efforts our lead facilitator will receive a stipend for participating in the Magnified Giving program, if permitted by District policy.
