Field Trip Requests traveling via Queen City Transportation:

Summit View Academy- 5th Grade

Summit View requests permission for 130 students to travel to Conner Prairie in Fisher's IN October 4, 2018. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:5. Transportation is via Queen City Transportation for reasons of distance and comfort. Meals will be student packed. Cost per student is \$35. Funds have been secured for indigent students.

Field Trip Requests traveling via District Bus:

Simon Kenton High School- Boys Soccer

Simon Kenton requests permission for 19 students to travel to Deer Park Elementary School in Owensboro, KY September 14-15, 2018 for a soccer match. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:3. Transportation is via District bus. Lodging will be at the Courtyard by Marriott 3120 Highland Pointe Dr. Owensboro, KY. Meals will be at Olive Garden and Chick Fil A. There is no cost per student.

Dixie Heights High School- Volleyball

Dixie requests permission for 14 students to travel to Louisville, KY September 28-29, 2018 for a volleyball tournament. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:2. Transportation is via District bus. Lodging will be at Home 2 Suites 3000 Crittenden Drive Louisville, KY. Meals will be at the hotel and Subway. There is no cost per student.

KCAIT- Military Prep

KCAIT requests permission for 30 students to travel to ECU in Richmond, KY September 29, 2018 for Raider Competition. Supervision will be provided by staff at a ratio of 1:10. Transportation is via District bus. Meals will be packed and at the Golden Corral, 185 E New Circle Rd. Lexington, KY. There is no cost per student.

Scott High School- Drama

Scott requests permission for 14 students to travel to River Park Center in Owensboro, KY November 9-11, 2018 for theatre workshops at the Drama Festival. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:4. Transportation is via District bus. Lodging will be at the Hampton Inn & Suites Owensboro, KY. Meals will be at McDonald's Georgetown, IN and Fetta Specialty Pizza in Owensboro KY. Cost per student will be \$250. This is a date change from the original request, which was approved at the August 2018 board meeting.
