Lesson Plans

SS-4-2.1.1 - Students will identify early cultures (Native American, Appalachian, pioneers) in Kentucky and explain their similarities and differences. SS-4-3.1.1 - Students will describe scarcity and explain how scarcity requires people in Kentucky to make economic choices (e.g., use of productive resources - natural, human, capital) and incur opportunity costs. Students will complete activities that identify and explain their similarities and differences to pioneers. Students will complete activities that show how pioneers used their resources in their communities and how they made economic choices with the resources that they had in the area. Students will complete a KWL chart on Kentucky pioneers. Students will research how pioneers lived off the land and what resources they had available to use. Students will also explain how pioneers traded with others. Students will complete a Venn-Diagram on how they are similar and different to pioneers of Kentucky. On the field trip students will complete activities that show how pioneers lived off the land by using candles for light, fire for warmth, wheels and water to make electricity, and caves were used for their benefits. After the trip the students will complete their KWL charts and produce a writing piece on pioneers and how they used the land and resources to survive.
