For **Presidents of State Postsecondary Educational Institutions and University Counsel,** this includes "each board of regents or governing board member of their university."

County judge/executives and mayors, or their designees, and school superintendents, and university presidents must also certify to the Attorney General that they have distributed "Your Duty Under the Law" and "Managing Public Records" as required. This is an ongoing duty. This form satisfies the requirement that all county judge/executives and mayors, or their designees, and school superintendents, and university presidents certify to the Attorney General that "Your Duty Under the Law" and "Managing Public Records" have been properly distributed.

I certify that I have distributed "Your Duty Under the Law" and "Managing Public Records" to all elected or appointed officials and elected or appointed members within sixty days of receipt of the newly revised publications from the Office of the Attorney General OR within sixty days of the day newly elected or appointed officials or members take office.
