ORDINANCE NO. ____:2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF MOREHEAD, KENTUCKY CODE OF ORDINANCES, TITLE 3, ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 39 CITY POLICIES, SECTION 39.04 RECREATION FEES

WHEREAS, the Recreation Department manages baseball, soccer, football, volleyball, basketball, and cheerleading sign ups;

WHEREAS, each activity has a sign-up period of no less than four weeks;

WHEREAS, sign-up periods are advertised on social media, the local newspaper and local radio stations;

WHEREAS, late sign-ups create delays in getting the programs started on time and additional expenses for uniform order corrections;

WHEREAS, the Director of Recreation has requested a late fee be imposed on sports sign-up for those signing up after the sign-up period has ended;

WHEREAS, K-2 Flag Football's fee was amended to \$40.00 last year, but did not get amended in the codification process and needs to be corrected;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of City Council of the City of Morehead, Kentucky that Title 3 Administration, Chapter 39 City Policies, Section 39.04 Recreation Fees, shall be amended as follows:

(E) Refund Policy: Morehead Parks & Recreation will issue a 50% refund for program registration fees if a refund request form is submitted prior to the participant being placed on a team; except for medical reasons or relocation of participant. A refund will not be issued once a participant is placed on a team. Refunds will be issued in the form of a check approximately 2-4 weeks after the request is made. Said request shall be submitted on a form provided by the City to the activity/program director for approval.

(F) Late Fees: There shall be a \$10.00 late fee for all participants that sign up after the published deadline for programs listed in paragraph (A) above.

(F) There shall be no charge for the following activities; Senior Feeling Good Monthly Program, Local Senior Games, Youth Baseball Diamond Skills, Youth Punt, Pass & Kick Contest, and Hershey's Tract and Field Event.
