We have an unusual number of illnesses pass through the schools in Month 1 which include flu, strep throat and mono.

Chronic absenteeism is defined as being absent (excused and/or unexcused) 10% or more of the year, during FY 18 16.83% of our student population was chronically absent. We sent 242 letters out to students who met this definition. The letter described the potential impacts academically absences have on children, ways to avoid absences and a request to contact me to discuss any problems the family may have with their child attending school. To date I have spoken with 23 families.

Additionally grade level appropriate posters were created for the schools to display on how absences impact students.

PBIS

Mr. Eagleson, Ms. Jenkins, Mrs. Evans, Mrs. Bush, Ms. Shadowen and I attended a PBIS Coaching Clinic sponsored by GRREC August 29, from 8:30-3:30. This workshop focused on coaching and team facilitation roles, use of behavioral data for decision-making, and progress-monitoring for student outcomes and fidelity of implementation so new coaches and administrators can effectively support their schools and districts in the implementation of PBIS.

We have a follow-up PBIS Leadership meeting that will focus on selecting a school PBIS team, review of student discipline data, and the preparation for our Tier 1/Tier 2 training taking place on September 26, 2018.
