September 2018 Board Meeting Special Education & Preschool Report

- 1. Preschool began Tuesday after Labor Day. There are 26 students enrolled in the program. There are 8 students enrolled in Children, Inc.
- 2. The preschool playground renovation is completed and the Preschool section in the library have been completed. The Book of the Week Program will begin in October with a kick off parent night to introduce the program to the parents.
- 3. Advertising for the <u>Little Lion Preschool</u> will begin soon. Little Lions up to age 3, and their parents, will be invited to participate in preschool for 1 hour the second Friday of each month. Preschool staff will facilitate literacy activities and families will leave with a book and activities to complete at home.
- 4. There are currently 21 Students with IEPs in learning in grades K-8. The number of students with speech IEP's is 34 and will see a slight increase as student in kindergarten and first grade are being screened for possible speech/language delay *These numbers are within the KDE maximum caseload requirements.
- 5. I am continuing to watch the increasing number of students identified with autism that are moving into the district. We have 2 students in Newport, 3 in preschool, 1 in kindergarten, and 1 in first grade. Newport's unit is full and they will not accept additional students. It may be time to consider creating a unit for next year.
- 6. Southgate's Medicaid application for the 2018-19 school year has been approved. Service providers will continue to bill for services.
- 7. I did apply for the Preschool Partnership Grant Tier 3. Awards were to be announced on Sept 10 but I have been informed it may not be until the end of next week!
