Lesson Plans

Standards taught:

K-LS1_1 Use observations to describe patterns of what plants and animals need to survive.

K-ESS2-1 Construct an argument supported by evidence for how plants and animals can change the environment to meet their needs.

K-ESS3-1 Use a model to represent the relationship between the needs of different plants or animals and the places they live.

Students will participate in a Unit on Animals and Life Cycles that will be taught the month of October. During this unit students will learn the things animals need to survive, how they can change the environment, and the different types of habitats that are necessary for each animal. We will also learn about body coverings and animal structures.

On the field trip Students will view the natural habitats of animals as recreated by the zoo. They will observe and compare the body coverings and structures of various animals. Chaperones and partners will discuss: body structures, body coverings, how the animal's basic needs are being met, what habitat was created for the animal, and how the animal is changing that environment. Following the trip students will engage in graphing, writing, and other lessons based on their zoo experiences.
