Lesson Plans

Lesson Plan for Hinton's Orchard

How this relates to our standards: This is the end of our unit of study on plant life cycles. This field trip will provide an authentic, hands-on learning experience about the needs of plants and plant life cycles.

K-LS1-1 Use observations to describe the patterns of what plants and animals (including humans) need to survive.

Activating schema: Read The Apple Pie Tree the day before the field trip. After reading and discussing, have the students brainstorm what they think they will see at the orchard.

Activity: At the orchard, students will take a ride out to the orchard. They will listen to how apple trees grow, and what they need to grow. Students will make observations about the trees in the orchard. Students will also go to the pumpkin field and listen to the guide explain the life cycle of pumpkins. Students will pick a pumpkin off the vine to take home.

Assessment: After we return to school, students will complete a circle chart that illustrates the life-cycle of a pumpkin.
