Transportation is via District Bus. Lodging will be at The Crowne Plaza Louisville, Ky. Meals will be provided by The Crowne Plaza Hotel and KY Youth Assembly. Cost per student is \$260. Cost per adult \$135. Funds have been secured for indigent students.

Field Trip Request-Kenton Elementary- Frankfort, Ky.

Kenton Elementary requests permission for 114 fifth grade students to take an educational trip to our State Capitol, Daniel Boone's Gravesite, and the Kentucky History Museum in Frankfort, Kentucky on Friday October 19, 2018. The instructional purpose and core content connection will be for students to see in person how state government works and to gain an appreciation for Kentucky Then and Now. Kenton Elementary faculty, staff, and parents at a ratio of 1:4 will provide supervision. Students will pack their lunch and eat on site during the trip. The approved Parent Permission Slip has been documented and will be sent to each student's parent/guardian. The cost of the trip is \$23.00 per student. Funds have been secured for indigent students. Transportation will be provided by Lakefront Lines Charter Buses due to size and comfort
