## Measuring and Tracking KCSD Goal for 3rd Grade Reading

District-Wide Goal: Students Reading on Grade Level Exiting 3<sup>rd</sup>- 95%

Criteria/ Measure: Any student who reaches a 583 Lexile measure at any time during 3<sup>rd</sup> grade will be identified as on grade level

## Why Lexile?

- Lexile is a nationally recognized measure for monitoring student growth and predicting future success in reading
- All KCSD interim reading assessments yield a Lexile reading measure (MAP, KPREP, SRI)

## Why 583L?

- 583L is equivalent to the 50th percentile for all third grade readers according to the national Lexile Typical Reader Measures by Grade Band
- 583 is equivalent to the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile on the MAP Reading Assessment for students in the third trimester of their third grade year
- 583 is equivalent to high apprentice on the third grade KPREP reading assessment
