



Amendment of *Kentucky Academic*Standards

Kentucky Board of Education October 3, 2018 704 KAR 3:303

Standards and Regulation

- 704 KAR 3:303: Kentucky Academic Standards.
- Once each new set of standards is adopted into regulation, 704 KAR 3:303 will only contain the Kentucky Academic Standards for the Arts, Science, Technology and Career Studies.
- The amendment of 704 KAR 3:303 will increase the efficiency of the standards review and revision process.



SB1 (2017) Standards Revision Requirements

The standards revision to the content standards shall:

- Focus on critical knowledge, skills, and capacities needed for success in the global economy;
- Result in fewer, but more in-depth standards to facilitate mastery learning;
- Communicate expectations more clearly and concisely to teachers, parents, students and citizens;
- Are based on evidence-based research;
- Consider international benchmarks; and
- Ensure the standards are aligned from elementary to high school to postsecondary education so students can be successful at each education level.



Standards (and Assessments) Review Process – to occur every 6 years Commissioner provides Committees formed: Commissioner takes to report to Review/Development Interim Joint Standards/Assessment Committee (RDC) and Committee on **Process Review** Advisory Panels (AP) **Education (IJCE)** Committee (SAPRC) **Public Comments** RDC reviews final SAPRC recommends sought on standards (by proposal; sends to proposed changes to third party) Commissioner KBE APs consider comments KBE approves proposed APs consider comments and changes and regulation propose/recommend and finalize proposed change process changes to the revisions commences standards New standards **RDC** reviews APs **Public Comments** implemented in all recommendations and sought on schools no later than makes decision on recommended revisions second academic year moving forward (by third party) following the process

Kentucky Academic Standards

Since the August KBE meeting:

- revisions were made to strike language in science related to connections in the Kentucky Academic Standards for English/Language Arts and Mathematics; and,
- language in the "Education Goals" listed on page one of the front matter was updated to reflect the revision of KRS 158.6451.
