- requires the Kentucky Board of Education to manage and control the common schools and all
- programs operated in the schools. KRS 160.290 authorizes local boards of education to provide
- for courses and other services for students consistent with the administrative regulations of the
- 16 Kentucky Board of Education. This administrative regulation incorporates by reference the
- 17 required academic standards, which contain the general courses of study and academic content
- standards for use in Kentucky's common schools <u>unless specifically incorporated in another</u>

- 20 Section 1. Before graduating from a Kentucky public high school, a student shall meet the
