6 RELATES TO: KRS 156.070, 156.160, 158.6451, 158.6453, 160.290

7 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 156.070, 156.160, 158.6453

8 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 156.160 requires the Kentucky Board

9 of Education to establish courses of study for the different grades and kinds of common schools,

10 with the courses of study to comply with the expected **goals**, outcomes, **and assessment**

11 **strategies developed under** [~~for students and schools established in~~] **KRS 158.645 and**

12 158.6451. KRS 158.6453 requires the revision of academic content standards. KRS 156.070(1)

13 requires the Kentucky Board of Education to manage and control the common schools and all

14 programs operated in the schools. KRS 160.290 authorizes local boards of education to provide

15 for courses and other services for students consistent with the administrative regulations of the

16 Kentucky Board of Education. This administrative regulation incorporates by reference the

17 required academic standards, which contain the general courses of study and academic content

18 standards for use in Kentucky's common schools **unless specifically incorporated in another**

19 **administrative regulation in Title 704, Chapter 8.**

20 Section 1. Before graduating from a Kentucky public high school, a student shall meet the

21 minimum content requirements established in the required academic standards.

22 Section 2. Incorporation by Reference. (1) The "Kentucky Academic Standards.", **October 2018,**

23 is incorporated by reference.
