Topic: 2018-2019 Local District Tax Rates Levied

Date: October 2018

Action Requested: Review Action/Consent Action/Discussion

SUMMARY OF ISSUE BEFORE THE BOARD:

To approve the 2018-2019 Local District Tax Rates Levied in accordance with KRS 160.470. KRS 160.470 requires the Kentucky Board of Education to approve local district tax rates each year.

COMMISSIONER'S RECOMMENDATION:

The Commissioner recommends that the Kentucky Board of Education (KBE) approve the 2018-2019 Local District Tax Rates Levied in accordance with KRS 160.470. Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) staff certify that the proposed school district tax rates provided in the attached document are in compliance with KRS 160.470.

APPLICABLE STATUTE OR REGULATION:

KRS 160.470

BACKGROUND:

Existing Policy: The KBE is required to approve the school district tax rates, if in conformity with KRS 160.470.

Summary of Issue: Upon receipt of certified property assessments from the Department of Revenue, the Commissioner of Education certifies the local ad valorem tax rates and revenue to the district boards of education in accordance with KRS 132.0225, 134.590(7), 157.440, 160.470, and 160.473. The district's board of education has forty five (45) days from the certification of assessment data to establish tax rates.

Staff is providing the most current list of districts requesting approval of their tax rates at the October meeting. Also included for the board's information is a chart (attachment) showing tax rates levied by type from 2012-2013 through 2018-19, and a definition page for the different kinds of tax rates.

Please note, due to a computer processing error, the Department of Revenue recertified Fayette County's property assessment after the Fayette County Board of Education adopted their tax rate. KDE and the Fayette County School Board were notified of the error and recertification. The recertification did not affect the tax rate.


Budget Impact: There is no budget impact at the state level.
