

Standards and Assessment Process Review Committee Findings Report

This findings report is to assist you in making the determination as to whether a sufficient public input process occurred during the development of the *Kentucky Academic Standards*. Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) 2017 outlined a detailed process for the revision and development of academic standards in the content areas of reading and writing, mathematics, social studies and science, and called for the creation of a Standards and Assessment Process Review Committee.

The committee's role, as outlined in SB 1 (2017), is to:

- review the commissioner's report;
- concur that stakeholders had adequate opportunity to provide input on standards, or find the input process deficient; and,
- provide certification of the determination to the Kentucky Board of Education.

The following documents, related to stakeholder input as well as those linked throughout the Commissioner's report should be reviewed, and can be found in the appendices: timelines for the standards revision process in both reading/writing and mathematics (Appendix A & B), public feedback on all surveys in both content areas (see list of resources provided to the IJCE list on page 9 of the report) and responses from IJCE members (Appendix C).
