CONSTRUCTION SUMMARY


This construction summary shows photos of the building the day we had our bi-weekly progress meeting and conducted a punch walk through of the kitchen and ceilings above the 8th grade classrooms. The kitchen is up and running and staff have moved into the space. Kitchen punch list items included finish items and areas where staff have requested modifications to the equipment layout. The above ceiling space in the 8th grade classroom was in good shape with a few exceptions of adding more ceiling support cables as well as demolition of abandoned wiring. The ceiling subcontractor was on site that day to address the ceiling work as the A/E team noted it.

Exterior work to complete includes finishing the new brick cornice that replaced the metal fascia panels at the roof line – this work will continue around the eastern portion of the building. EH Construction's goal is to wrap up the roof abatement and recoating work by the end of October – the dry weather is helping them meet this goal. The exterior bus canopy will be painted and cleaned up as well.

Aside from work noted on the last punch list, Area B &C interior work is complete. Punch list items are being addressed by EH and their subcontractors while they continue to renovate the classrooms. You'll see on the phasing plan included with this memo that the first 8th grade classrooms are being turned over to the school after fall break. EH will continue phasing the classrooms until January. There will be five more classroom phases and EH expects to finish those every two to three weeks. The A/E team will plan to punch those classroom spaces after every progress meeting to keep on schedule and note any areas of repair prior to students and staff moving back in.

Photos included in this memo include rooms that have been renovated as well as in-progress renovated classroom images.


Areas noted noted in red. in green are nearing completion or are complete. The areas currently under construction are Yellow indicates areas left to complete






