## **CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM DATA 2017/2018**

The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) defines chronically absent as a student who is present 90% or less of full-time equivalency. If a student misses 10% or more of the school year for any reason - excused, unexcused, suspensions (exceptions are exempt absences such as field trips, EHO, AFD, AFR, ATA, College Visit) - then the student is considered Chronically absent. This is not the same thing as Truancy. Truancy is based on Unexcused absences only and Chronic Absenteeism is based on missing school for any reason, excused and unexcused.
