Consent Agenda genda Item (Action Item):

Request approval for interested high school students identified in the Gifted & Talented Program from Betsy Layne, Floyd Central, and Prestonsburg to participate in a study tour of Washington, DC. The tour will depart Saturday, October 5 and return Tuesday, October 8, 2019.

Applicable Statute or Regulation:

KAR 704 3:285 Section 6, Board Policy 09.36

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact:

The Washington, DC study tour will be funded through parent contribution combined with funding from the Gifted & Talented field trip budget. Fund raising will be offered to any student requesting assistance in order to participate. The tour is scheduled for Saturday, October 5 - Tuesday, October 8, 2019. These dates coincide with Big Sandy Community & Technical College Fall Break. Therefore, the high school students will only miss two school days and the FCECA students who choose to participate will not miss any college classes. Also, students involved in fall sports will be able to participate because we will not depart until Saturday morning. The GT coordinator, instructor, and administrators will be student chaperones.

History/Background:

Within the past thirteen school years gifted and talented $9^{th} - 12^{th}$ graders from Floyd County high schools have been given the opportunity to tour Washington, DC, New York City, Chicago Illinois, the Biltmore Estate in Asheville North Carolina, Boston, Massachusetts, Niagara Falls, New York and Central Florida. These tours have been some of the best "real world" experiences I have ever participated in with high school students. For some students, these tours have been their first time to travel to a major metropolitan city. The GT students, their parents, GT program personnel, and school administrators recommend that the Floyd County Board of Education approve the request for those gifted & talented students interested in participating in the Washington, DC study tour October 5-8, 2019 be allowed to do so pending compliance with all Board policies.
