Students/teacher are unable to fundraise for that much money. He needs them replaced by the 2019-20 Fall Semester. CM – This would be brought to the board to ask for help with this purchase. -\$1200.00 worth of donuts were sold to raise money for the current band repairs and supplies that are needed.

-Questions about doing a raffle would be sent to the Board Office to Stacy McKnight. -PH would like to set up a table in the lobby in the A.M. to meet JRS. as they arrive in the morning, for any questions they may have about fundraising or their Senior Trip. -TH Hold possible competition by grade level about various events and give reward in December.

TEACHER CONCERNS-TB said that the transition from the coliseum to the gym in the mornings went smooth. The students are still not eating a lot. Maybe if there were more/better food options they may eat more often.

-Discussion of possible salad bar being brought back. The committee would like to invite Tabitha Turner for the next meeting to discuss possible options.

-CM -Possibility of giving a cold option of breakfast in the morning, in the gym with a share table. If they still seem to not be eating then maybe do a student survey about what to add/remove from the menu. Also look at other schools and see what they serve.

PUBLIC CONCERNS – SS expressed her concerns about school programs and the lack of a teacher. Council had stated that a Full Time teacher had indeed been hired and would be starting that following Monday.
