IX.B. Acceptance of a Report on the 2017–18 State Accountability Results

Dr. Pollio introduced this item. Dr. Dena Dossett, chief of accountability, research, and systems improvement; Dr. Devon Horton, chief of schools; and Dr. Nate Meyer, assistant superintendent of school turnaround, presented the report on District results regarding the individual components of proficiency, separate academic indicator, growth, transition readiness, and graduation rates. The report also summarized positive trends and areas for growth and identified next steps for accelerated improvement schools. Each Board member had an opportunity to comment and ask questions.

Multiple Board members were optimistic with the District's new Accelerated Improvement Schools Office that provides schools with special support and attention.

Mr. Gies showed acknowledged that reading and social studies scores were some of the highest in history.

Mrs. Horne was pleased to see that Westport Middle School is now a level 1 school. She inquired about the increased oversight and accountability for level 2 and 3 schools to improve.

Mrs. Duncan expressed concern and questioned how the new state graduation requirements will impact the District. Dr. Dossett announced that the public comment period regarding the new requirements goes through November 30.

Mr. Brady was apprehensive with the District declaring KDE as the audit and turnaround team for schools since they don't have a great track record with previous priority schools. He was also concerned with the amount of funding available to help schools get out of CSI status once the number of schools increases in subsequent years. Dr. Pollio stated that he expressed the same concern at the state level.

Chair Porter stated that she is not satisfied but she is confident that the District has the right people in the right place to do the work.

Mr. Brady was concerned and stated that some people have participated and acted as full committee members during the Audit and Risk Management Advisory Committee meetings even though they had not been approved by the Board yet. He was also concerned with the appointment of Dr. Vicki Phillips since she has made some controversial decisions as a superintendent in the past and was the education director for the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation which believes in the increased privatization of public schools. He preferred to revise the motion to approve the other recommended committee members separately from Dr. Vicki Phillips.

Dr. Willner clarified that this committee has no authority to act – they only have the authority to make recommendations to the Board. Dr. Pollio confirmed Dr. Willner's statement.

Mr. Gies pointed out the benefit of diversity in opinion within a committee. Mr. Brady agreed with this point but stated that he did not want to repeat a mistake and that Dr. Phillips had very similar experience as a person that the Board had dealt with in the past and they were not fond of it.

Mr. Brady was concerned and wanted clarification with who the general counsel will report to and that the Board is able to hire the superintendent, the board secretary, board treasurer, and legal counsel. He stated that he sought clarification from KSBA and they have the same interpretation of the law, stating that the Board does have the ability to hire a legal counsel. He wants to be clear on who they report to. They are legal counsel to the Board – not the superintendent or the District.

Mr. Mellen stated that the agenda item reflects the language of the statutes and he has communicated with John Fogle, staff attorney at KSBA, who stated that he does not give individual advice to school districts on particular issues, only general advice.

Mr. Mellen explained that Mr. Fogle said that when the statutes say a board member can influence the hiring of the board attorney, it means that they can appoint the board attorney and he thinks that is what the Legislature intended – although, he agrees that this is not exactly what the statute says. The statute says that the board can *influence* the hiring.

Mr. Mellen stated that the definition of the word influence is to affect or give consultation or give advice on, but it doesn't mean the power of appointment and that is where Mr. Mellen says he differs with Mr. Fogle.

Mr. Mellen went on to say that the issue of reporting is set forth in the organizational chart and job description and that the general counsel reports to the Board members but functionally, as an employee of the school district, also reports to the superintendent.
