 - Participation in a KDE CSI Meeting

 - Submitted the Wood Hudson PLTW collaborative proposal for their Board of Directors to approve
 - Participation in the River Cities Training Hub Network meetings
 - Participation in Torch Prep collaboration planning meetings with NHS
