PBIS

Discipline Committee

To date the committee has met and reviewed three (3) level 4 offenses, in two (2) cases students participated in a restorative practice and received less of a disciplinary consequence and in the third case a long-term suspension was avoided.

Reports in Progress

LEAD (Local Educator Assignment Data) - The LEAD report is a semiannual report done by local school districts to ensure there is a properly certified educator in every position. Most errors have been cleaned up and report will be submitted prior to the November 1st deadline.

Growth Factor- The Growth Factor Report is submitted to KDE prior to November 1 of each school year. Attendance information reported on Growth Factor for the first two (2) school months includes:

- aggregate days attendance and absences
- race and gender counts
- adjustments for partial day students
- nonresident and no-contract students
- over-age and under-age students

The Growth Factor has been submitted without errors. The district is down approximately 32 students, we will not receive any additional funding from the submission nor will the district lose any funds for our decreased enrollment.

Impact Aid - SECTION 7003 basic support payments for federally connected children compensate school districts for educating students, whose parents or legal guardians reside and/or work on Federal property, including children of members of the uniformed services.

The U.S. Department of Education requires an annual resolution be passed at an official meeting of the governing body of the local educational agency authorizing the filing of an application and designating the person to file the application for Impact Aid. The district receives approximately \$12,000.00 in Section 7003 funding from this reimbursement.

Letters explaining Impact Aid went home on October 18, completed surveys are due back into the schools by Friday, November 2, 2018.
