Pursuant to KRS 157.655-157.660 and 750 KAR 2:010, the School Facilities Construction Commission (SFCC) is hereby making an official FY-2019 KETS offer of assistance to your Board of Education. Acceptance of this offer of assistance commits the Board of Education to follow the statutes and regulations of the SFCC and the Kentucky Department of Education governing the Education Technology Funding Program. Based on final FY-2018 statewide ADA figures, your first offer of assistance in FY-2019 is in the amount of \$32,510. Accepted state technology fund offers of assistance must be matched equally by your Board of Education or can be escrowed for up to three (3) years. Please note that the education technology funds restricted account has a new designation in the MUNIS chart of accounts: Fund 2, Project 162E EdTech account. - Excerpt of Board of Education meeting minutes (accepting, escrowing, or rejecting offer within 60 days from the date of offer)

From this point forward, KETS offers of assistance will be delivered to you via email. A copy will also be sent to your district's Director of Finance. For your convenience, documents regarding your KETS offer will be accepted
