Lesson Plans

Students will be attending the Stage One presentation of *Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing* written by Judy Blume. Prior to attending the play, students will be reading the book and reviewing how we analyze the text for story elements (RL.4.3), a skill previously taught, and how we use these elements to help deepen our understanding of text and characters. Students will use the book to draw inferences (RL.4.1) about characters and their actions. Earlier in the year students were taught how to determine the theme and summarize (RL.4.2) and we will be able to use this as a review of skills and a way to deepen understanding and demonstrate knowledge in writing. We will also use this opportunity to analyze the differences in stories and drama (RL.4.5) so that we can compare and contrast the elements after the field trip. At lunch, students will engage in appropriate discussions (Speaking & Listening 4.6). Leading up to the trip, teachers will spend time teaching the proper discourse for the setting while also incorporating character education lessons around respect.
