Consent Agenda Item (Action Item):

Students will visit the Statue of Liberty, Ellis Island, 911 Memorial, Central Park, Rockefeller Center, Times Square, Grand Central Station and various other historic/educational sites as outlined in the agenda. The charter bus will depart for the trip on April 3, 2019 and return back April 7, 2019. This trip will occur during Spring Break.

History/Background:

Each year our Social Studies scores have been some of the highest in the state and currently we are the #3 ranked middle school in the state of Kentucky. In order to maintain this level of performance we want to expose our students to current and past historical information that will bring history to life. Additionally, many of our students have not had the opportunity to travel outside of our area and we feel this is an educational opportunity that many would not have otherwise.
