CONSTRUCTION SUMMARY

This construction summary shows photos of the building the day we conducted a punch walk through of the 8th grade classrooms as well as work being done in the 7th grade corridor during our October 30th progress meeting.


The 8th grade corridor and adjacent classrooms are now fully occupied. The punch list contained items related to finishes, mostly painting, and wrapping up installation of casework components. EH Construction is currently working on the next classroom phase in the 7th grade corridor. Work to be completed in occupied areas of the school (Areas B & C) is being done during 2nd shift.

The exterior masonry work is now complete with the new brick cornice fully installed. EH Construction has roughly 5,000 square feet of new roofing left to install as of October 30th. The design team is on call to verify work has been completed on the roof during the month of November.

EH is currently working on the third classroom wing phase – they have three phases left to complete before January. EH is keeping to a two to three-week schedule on the phases because most of the infrastructural work was done during the summer which allows them to focus on the remaining selective demolition and installation of finishes at the classrooms and corridors. The floor slab moisture mitigation occurs concurrently with each classroom phase. The final classroom phase to be finished will be along the west side of the 7th grade corridor at the FMD and EBD classrooms – the school asked for these students not to be displaced during the rest of the fall semester. Work at these specialized classrooms is scheduled to be completed during Winter Break.

SKA and EH will be working through a final punch schedule for the remainder of the project. The substantial completion date is set for January 2nd, 2019.


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
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PHASING DIAGRAM & AREAS OF CONSTRUCTION


