Dear Jay:

For the last three years, the Campbell County Public Library has been partnering with the fourteen public elementary schools in Campbell County in a project called "Drop Your Drawers." During the months of November and December, we collect packs of new underwear suitable for grades K-5 at all of our locations then distribute the underwear to the family resource centers. Last year, we collected over 7000 pairs of underwear. Since the program began, we've collected 20,000 pairs.

Our goal is to help your staff keep your students at school and in the learning environment through the entire school day comfortably. Clean underwear that fits should not be a barrier to learning.

This year, we're hoping that the school superintendents and school boards will allow the Library to photograph you and the school board donating a pack of underwear to the campaign. We'd feature the picture on our social media platforms. In the past, we've done the same photos with city councils and the Fiscal Court.
