The Purpose of the Ky School Technology Enhancement grant is to provide support for innovative technology projects. Henderson County submitted a grant to provide 25 wireless routers and service plans to support the routers. These wireless routers will be available to students who don't currently have internet service at their home. They can check them out from their media center and take home with them for an evening. This will enable the student to utilize their Chromebook for homework/ class assignments that otherwise they wouldn't be able to do. The routers will be available to students at North, South and HCHS. CAS and elementary students are not allowed to take their Chromebooks home. These routers will have filters in them that prevent access to inappropriate websites. This is a one-time purchase grant.

The grant will allow the purchase of the routers and the service plans for the first year.
