

## Board Report for 12/19/2018

- DHS students in grades 9-11 took the CERT test on December 4<sup>th</sup>.
- 19 seniors took KYOTE Math College Readiness and/or Reading Placement exams at DHS on December 5<sup>th</sup>, with no students meeting math or reading benchmarks.
- DMS students in grades 7-8 took the CASE test on December 6<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup>.
- DHS currently has 43 students that are Transition Ready:
  - 29 seniors
  - 12 juniors
  - 2 sophomores
- 92% of seniors have applied to college:
  - 48 seniors have submitted 118 applications to 19 different schools
  - 16 seniors have received acceptance letters to 7 different schools
  - 4 seniors have received \$124,000 in scholarship offers
- Lifetouch visited DHS for Senior Picture Day on December 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Several DHS students took the National ACT test on December 8<sup>th</sup>.
- The dual credit students have finished their first semester of classes at Gateway Community and Technical College.
- Mrs. Embry and Mrs. Erdman traveled to Louisville for Infinite Campus training on December 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>.
- Mrs. Embry has joined the Advisory Council for Campbell County Area Technology Center's Health Sciences program.
- Midterm exams are scheduled to take place in grades 7-12 on Wednesday, December 19<sup>th</sup> – Friday, December 21<sup>st</sup>.
- The Culture and Climate Committee is hosting an End-of Semester Faculty and Staff Celebration on December 21<sup>st</sup>.
