### December 2018

- Students in grades kindergarten through sixth grade have finished their winter 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter CASE Assessments. These tests tell teachers and administrators how well the students are doing mastering the Common Core Standards.
- Our Fall Round of ATMs (Advisory Team Meetings) took place over these last couple of weeks. We determined students who are struggling academically and developed next steps and interventions for each student. Our intermediate students who are failing one or more classes are on their *Contract to Pass* – a contract that helps them stay focused on ways to help them succeed.
- Our afterschool club offerings and sports continue to grow. We have our Robotics Club and wrestling are now underway and our Drama Club will begin immediately following winter break.
- The PTC continues to be an active organization at Lincoln Elementary. They recently hosted their annual Santa Shop and a Holiday Family Fun Night on Friday, December 14<sup>th</sup>.
- SBDM Committee Work –
  - PBIS Team – This team continues to meet to discuss implementation progress of our school-wide PBIS framework. Additional enhancements continue to be implemented on a regular basis based on student behavior data results, staff surveys, and committee collaboration.
  - Curriculum Team – The curriculum team continues to work with Mr. Wolf on to implement the LES Writing Plan school-wide.
  - Instructional Strategies Team – This committee working with Mrs. Dragan just encouraged each teacher to submit a Peer Observation Wish List. This will help give our teachers opportunities to see their peers teaching specific instructional strategies.
