Fidelity is ensured through eWalks, having an instructional specialist to support teachers who might have not been at the school with the initial training in say Thoughtful Education, reports from programs like Read 180 and Math 180, and tracking programs to ensure that during eWalks specific strategies are marked such as Kagen, TE, Olweus, etc. Programs like MAP and Edugenuity are watched heavily through observations and administration working with students in those settings.

Describe how the program/strategy listed above is monitored and data/progress is used for improvement.

Data from eWalks is reviewed weekly and a district eWalk is reviewed three times a year. Additional data such as Read 180 or Math 180 are reviewed during those content PLCs. Other programs like Edugenuity have reports as well, but the data collected from MAP, KPREP like assessments, and PLC grading of various work should show an increase of proficiency.
