Literacy First process Grades PreK-2, Everyday Math Grades K-5, Lexia Learning grades K-5

Describe how your school ensures that the program/strategy listed above is implemented with fidelity.

Literacy First process is implemented in PreK-3 classrooms. A schedule is created where each classroom has an hour of small group and an hour of large group instruction daily. Literacy First assessment results are analyzed in PLC meetings bi-weekly. Administration walkthroughs check for fidelity to the process. Everyday Math implemented school-wide. Our master schedule includes an hour and fifteen minute block for every grade level. Administration walkthroughs indicate fidelity to the program. Lexia Learning is being utilized K-5 in Reading. Students are scheduled daily to complete Lexia minutes. Program reports are reviewed quarterly to ensure fidelity to the program. Reflex math is being used K-5 to support math facts. Again, students are scheduled daily to complete Reflex minutes. Program reports are reviewed quarterly to ensure fidelity to the program.

Describe how the program/strategy listed above is monitored and data/progress is used for improvement.

Literacy First assessment results are reviewed in PLC bi-monthly. Those results determine the groups students work in to meet their individual level. Students move along a continuum as they make progress. Everyday Math implementation is monitored through the use of common assessments at each grade level. Those results are reviewed in PLC teams bi-weekly and used to changed instruction. Lexia learning and Reflex math are both monitored by student progress on program reports. These are analyzed quarterly to ensure progress.
