Our student-to-teacher ratio is approximately 15:1 and our teacher's average years of teaching experience is 10 years. Our school is currently 60% students from military families. One of our low-incidence teachers serves on the council for exceptional children Kentucky chapter in the vice president role this year and will be president elect next year.
