Hey Beau,

I have attached a Wage Sheet for you that gives you a few scenarios. I ran numbers on a new graduate (Rank 2, Step 0) and a Retiree (Rank 2, Step 22). These are just estimates as a retiree could come in as a Rank 1, which would lower the days you could afford that person. The scenarios included on the wage sheet are for 7.25 hrs/day (all day), 5 hrs/day, 6 hrs/day and 4 hrs/day. I highlighted the columns that show the hours/day and the days/year. Just for reference, not including any Bullitt Days, Holidays, etc, there are 88 instructional days left from Jan. 7 thru the end of the year.
