Average number of days per student = 3.19

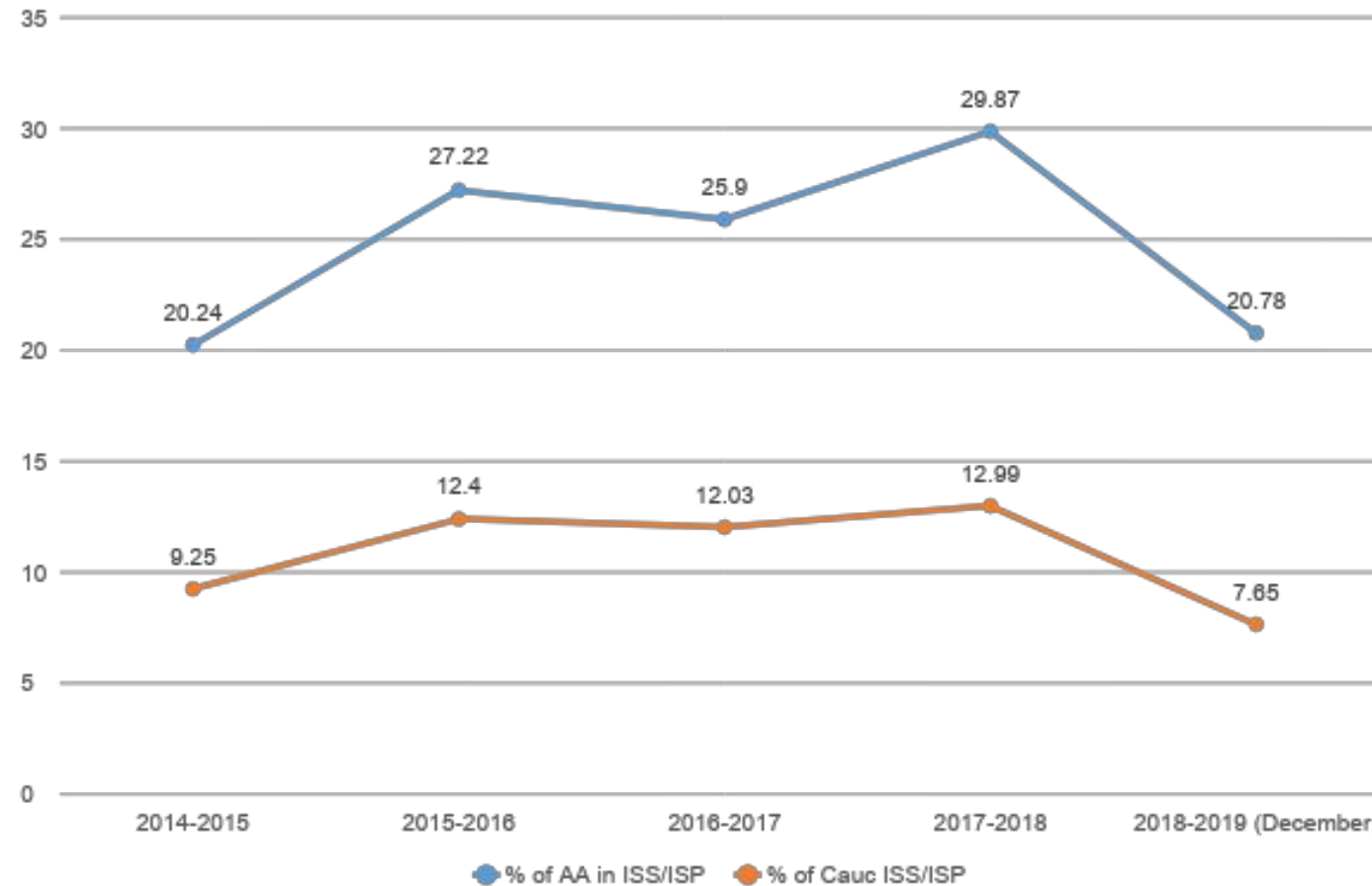
343 Caucasian students have gone to ISS and/or ISP

Total number of days assigned = 962 assigned instructional days

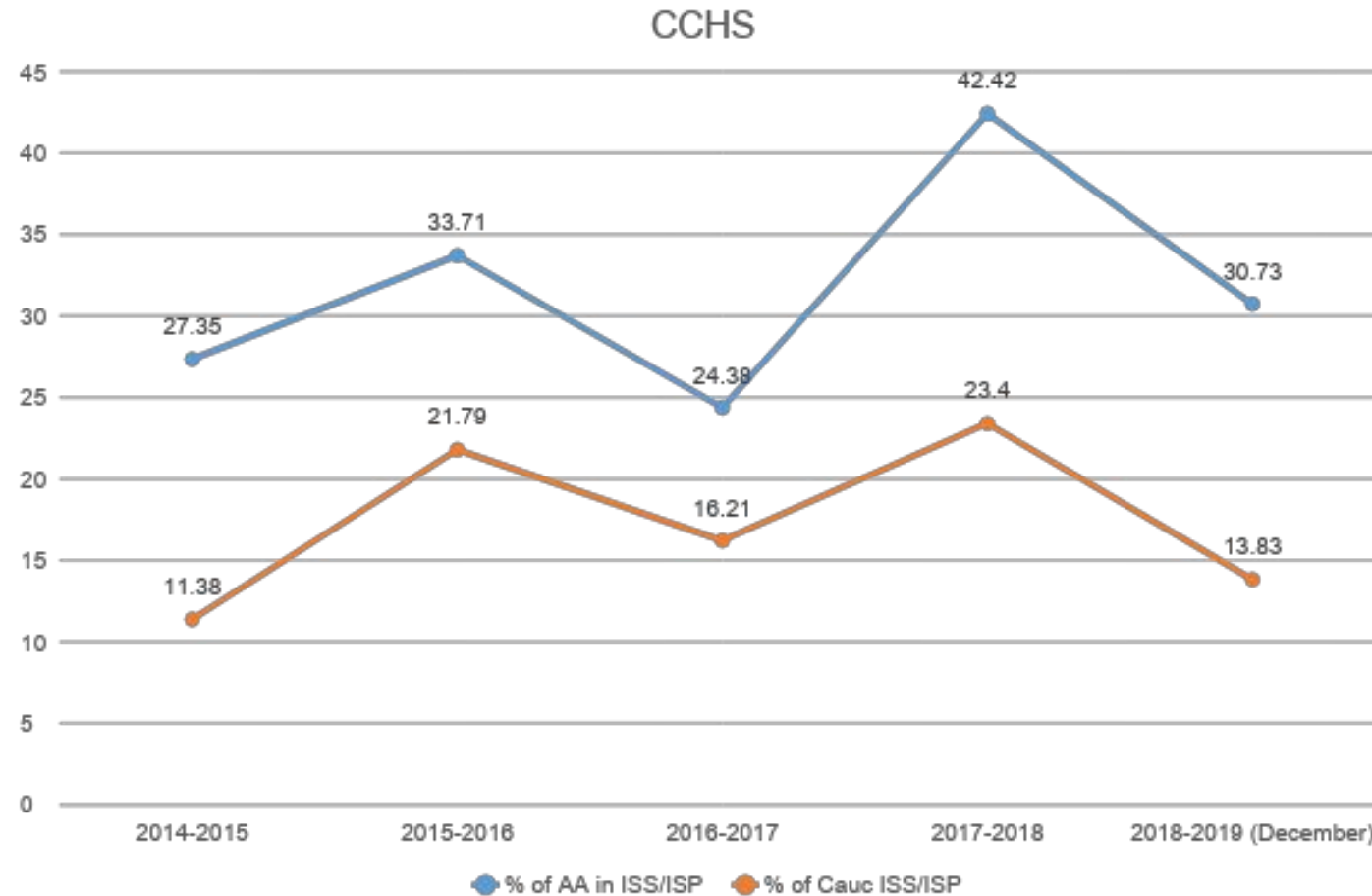
Average number of days per student = 2.80

# Percentage of Students in ISS/ISP (District)

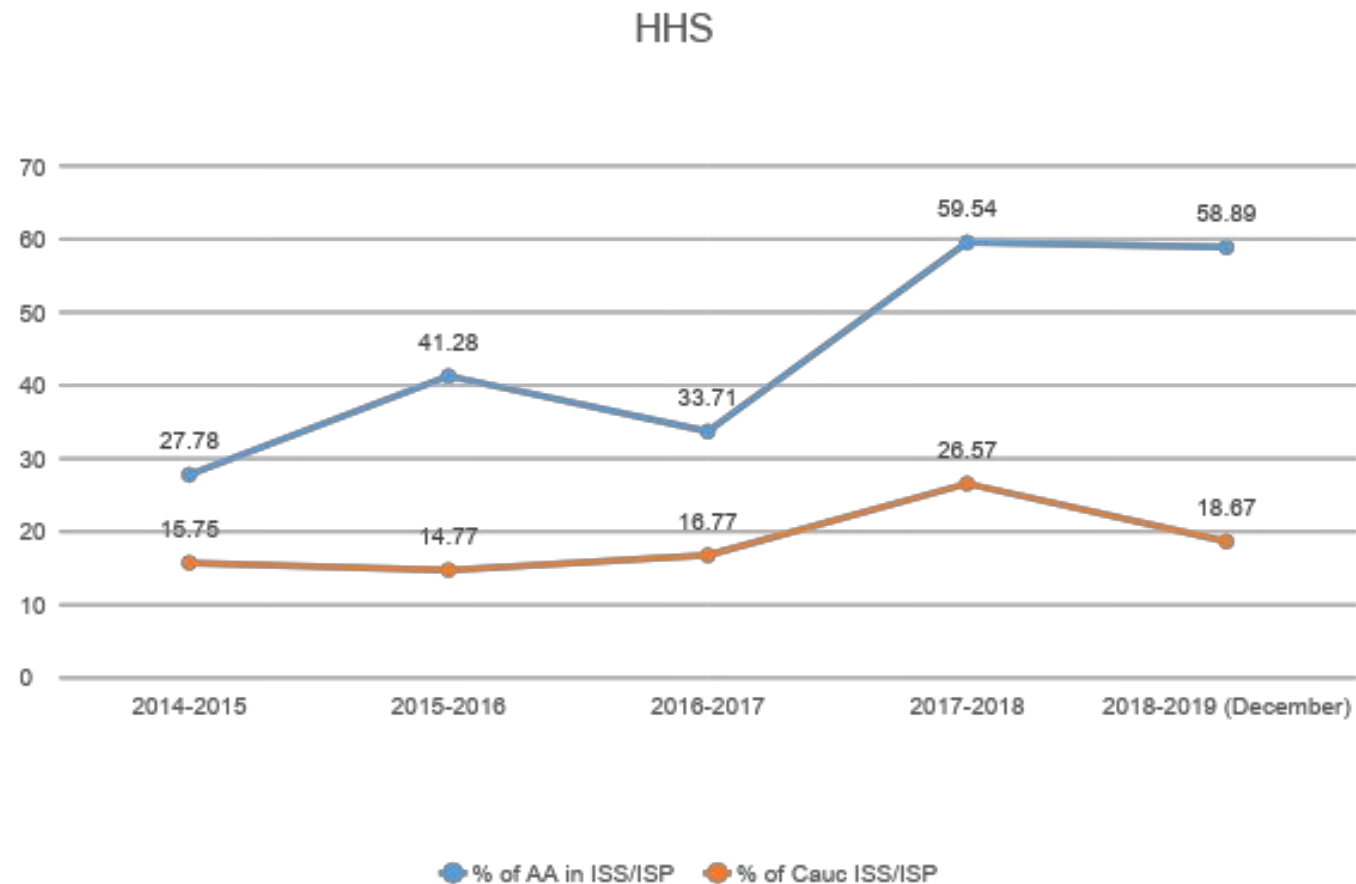

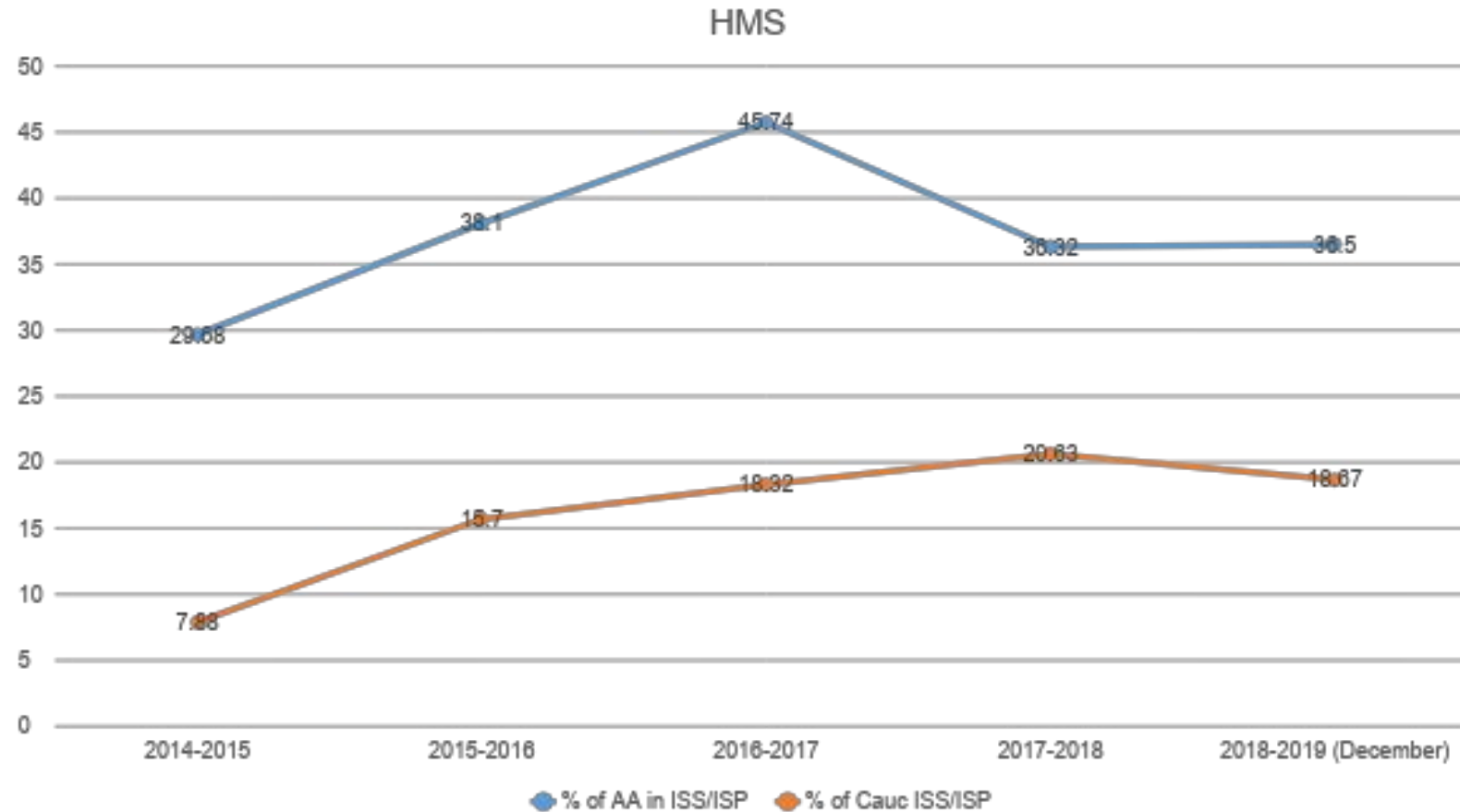

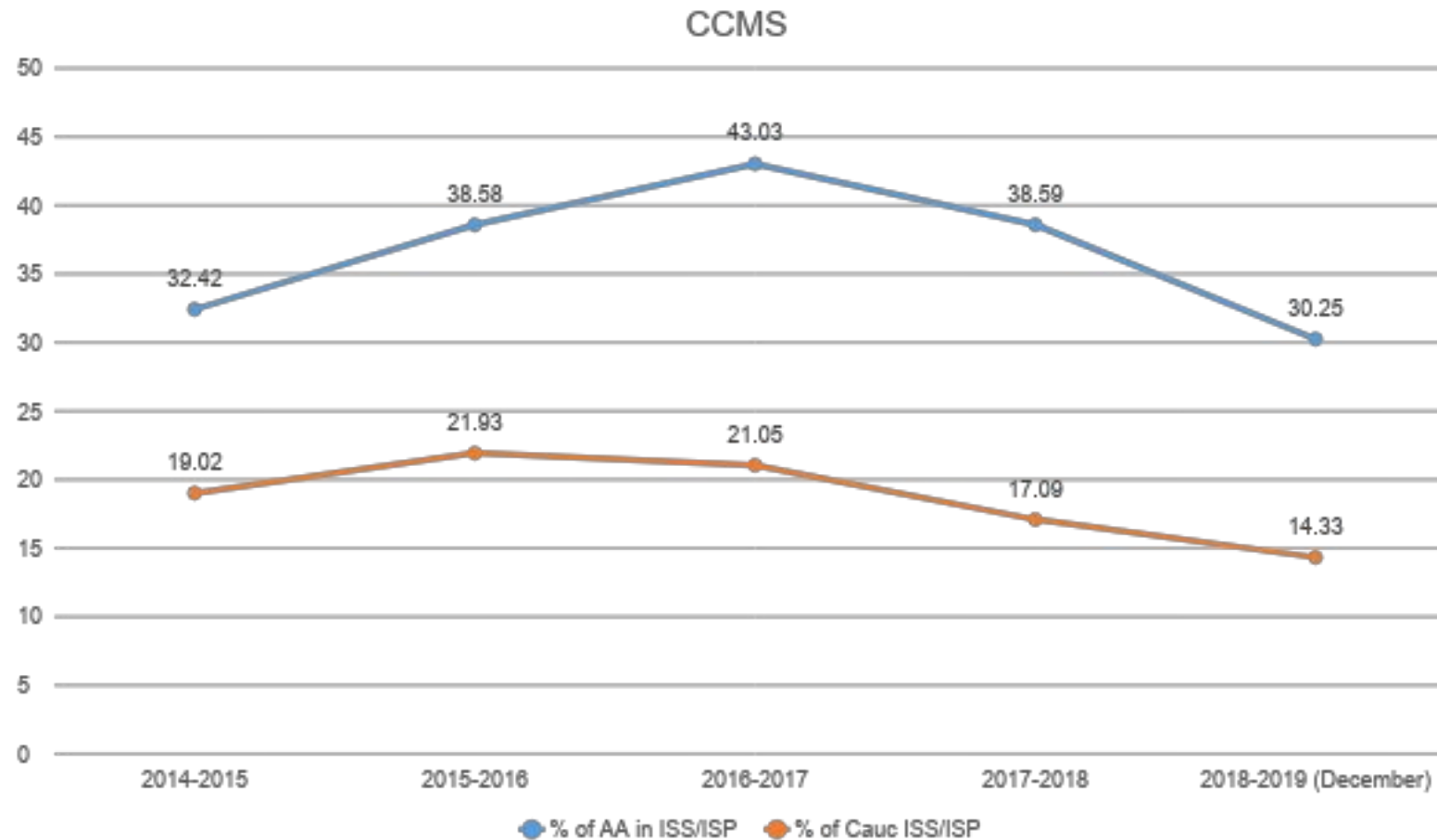
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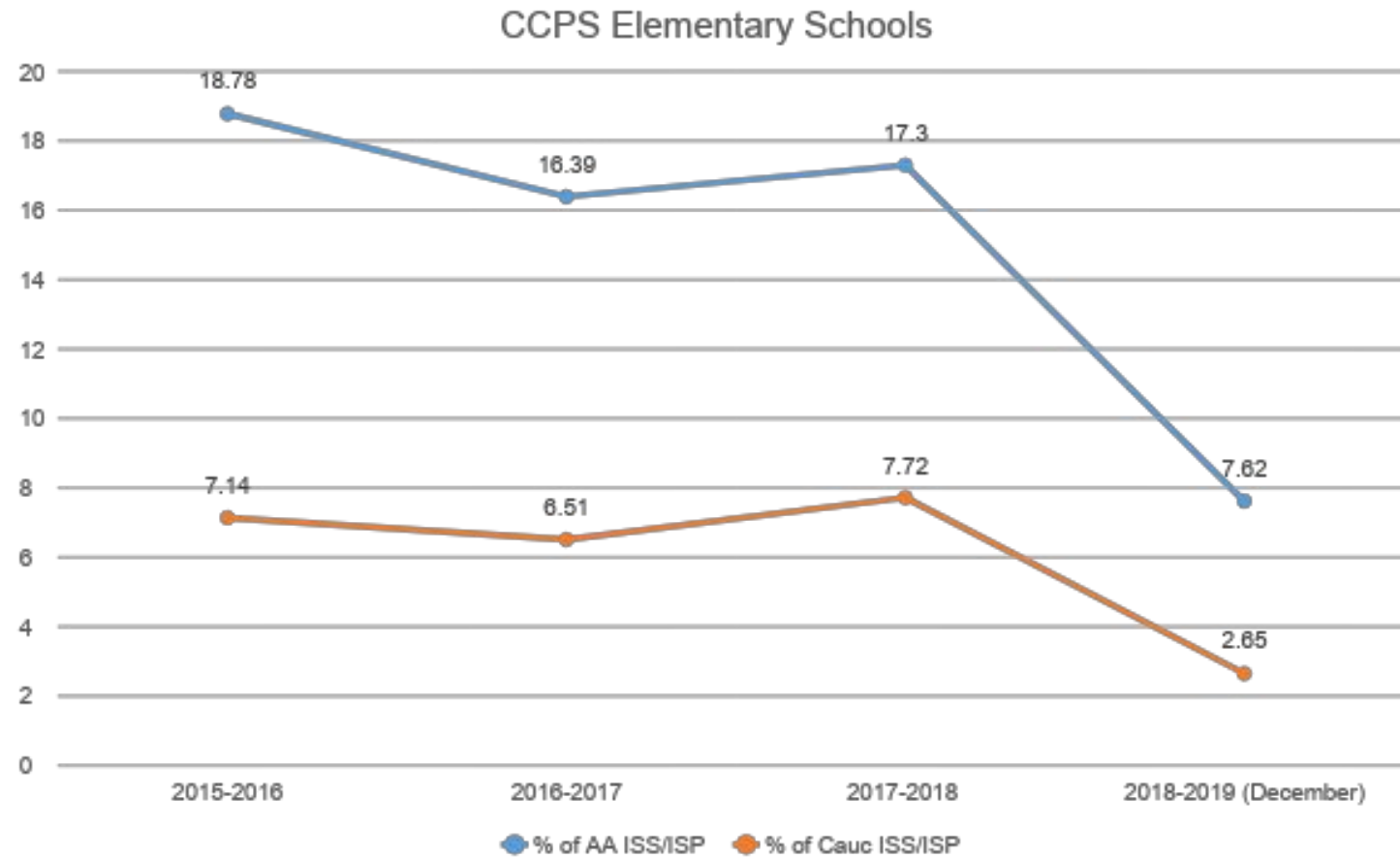

Average number of days per students = 1.98

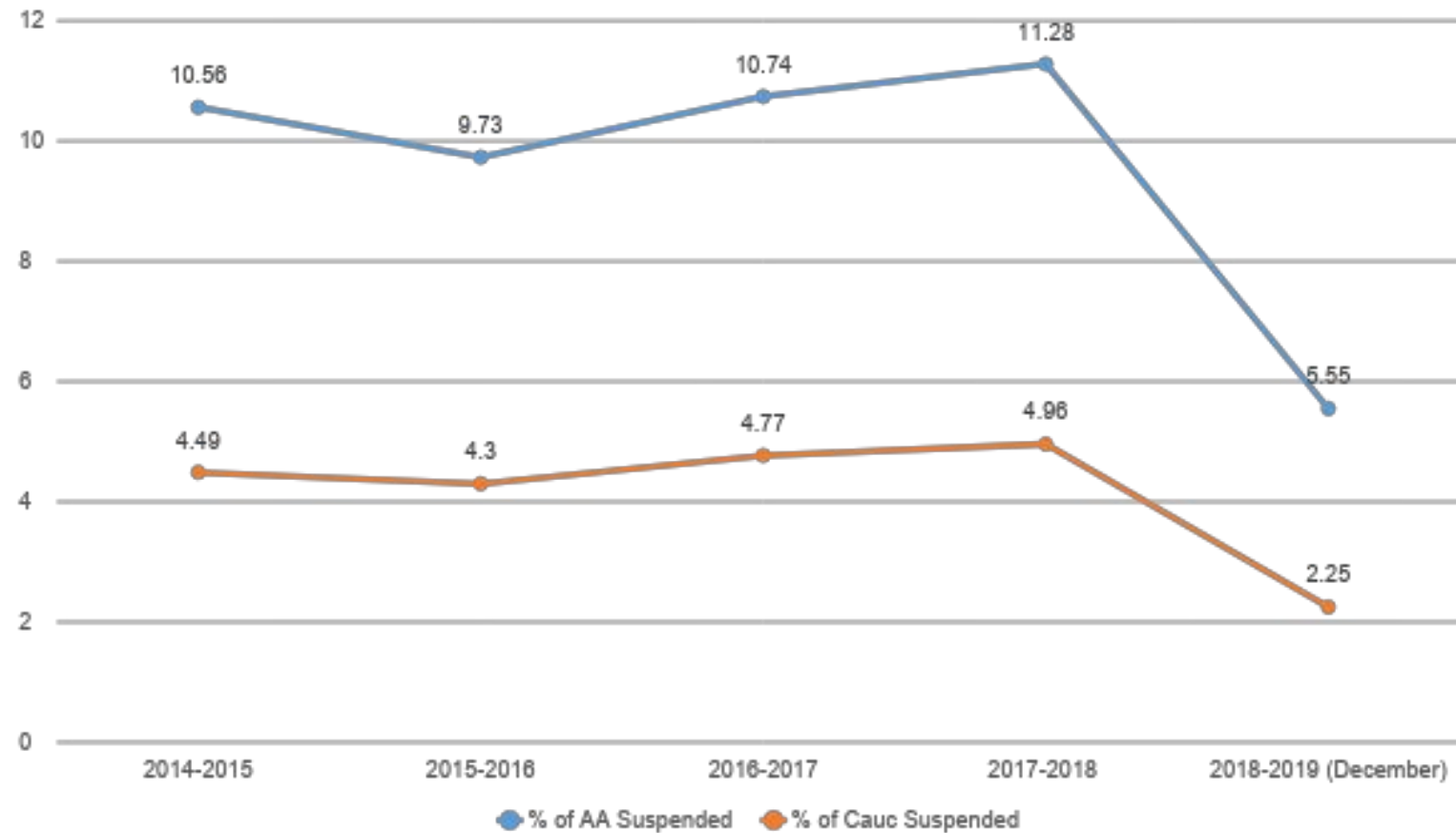
101 Caucasian students were suspended

Total number of suspension days = 288 instructional days

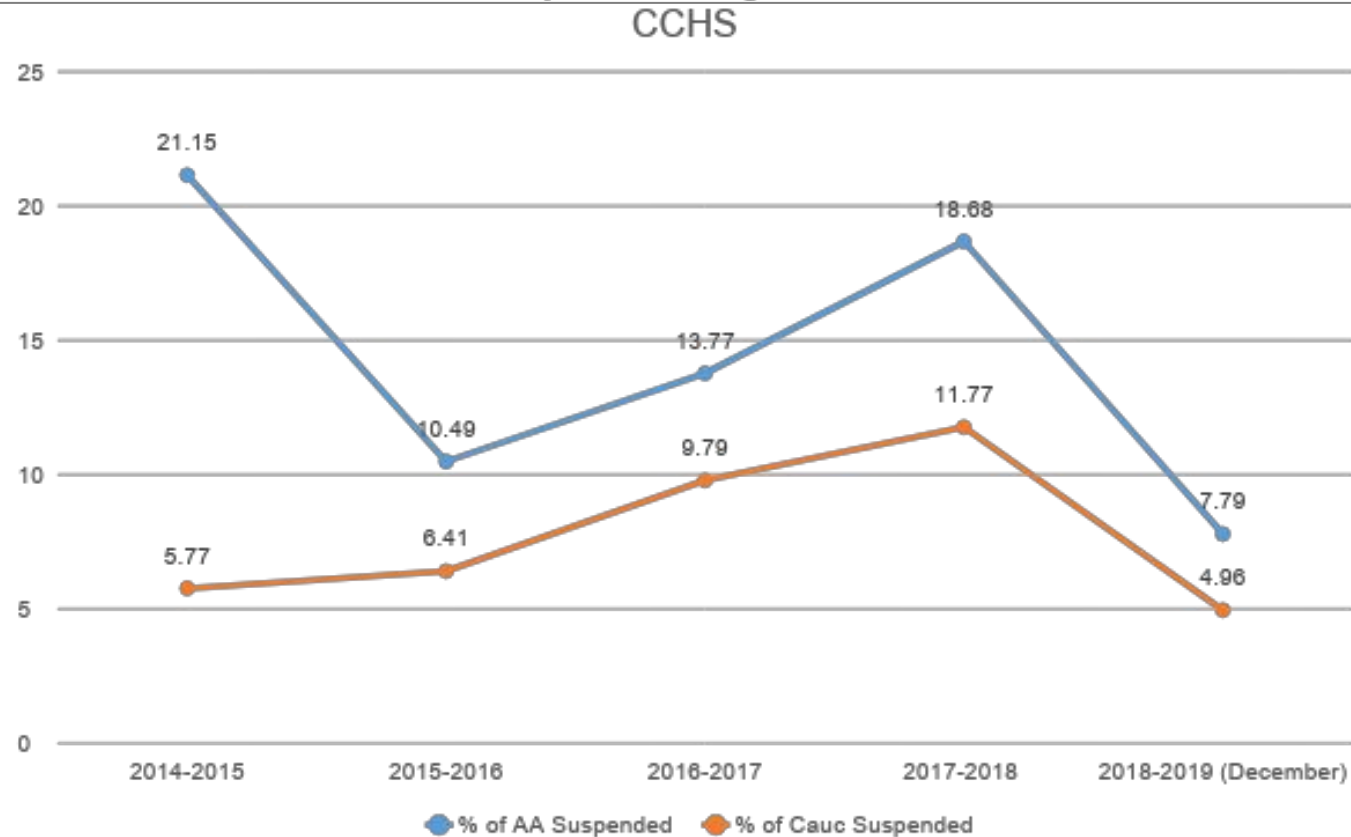
Average number of days per student = 2.85

Total number of instructional days lost for both AA and Cauc = 613

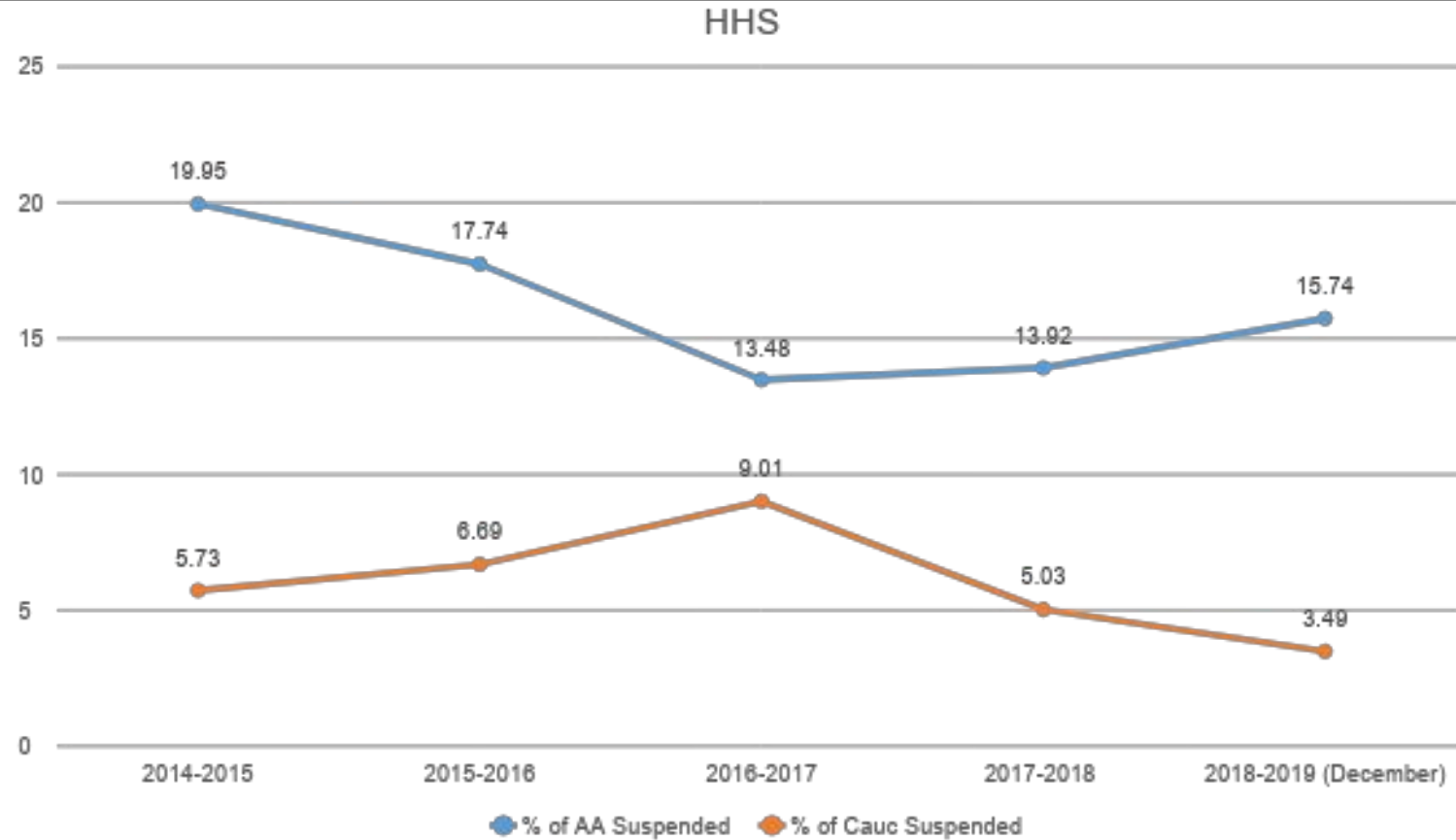
# Percentage of Students Suspended - District

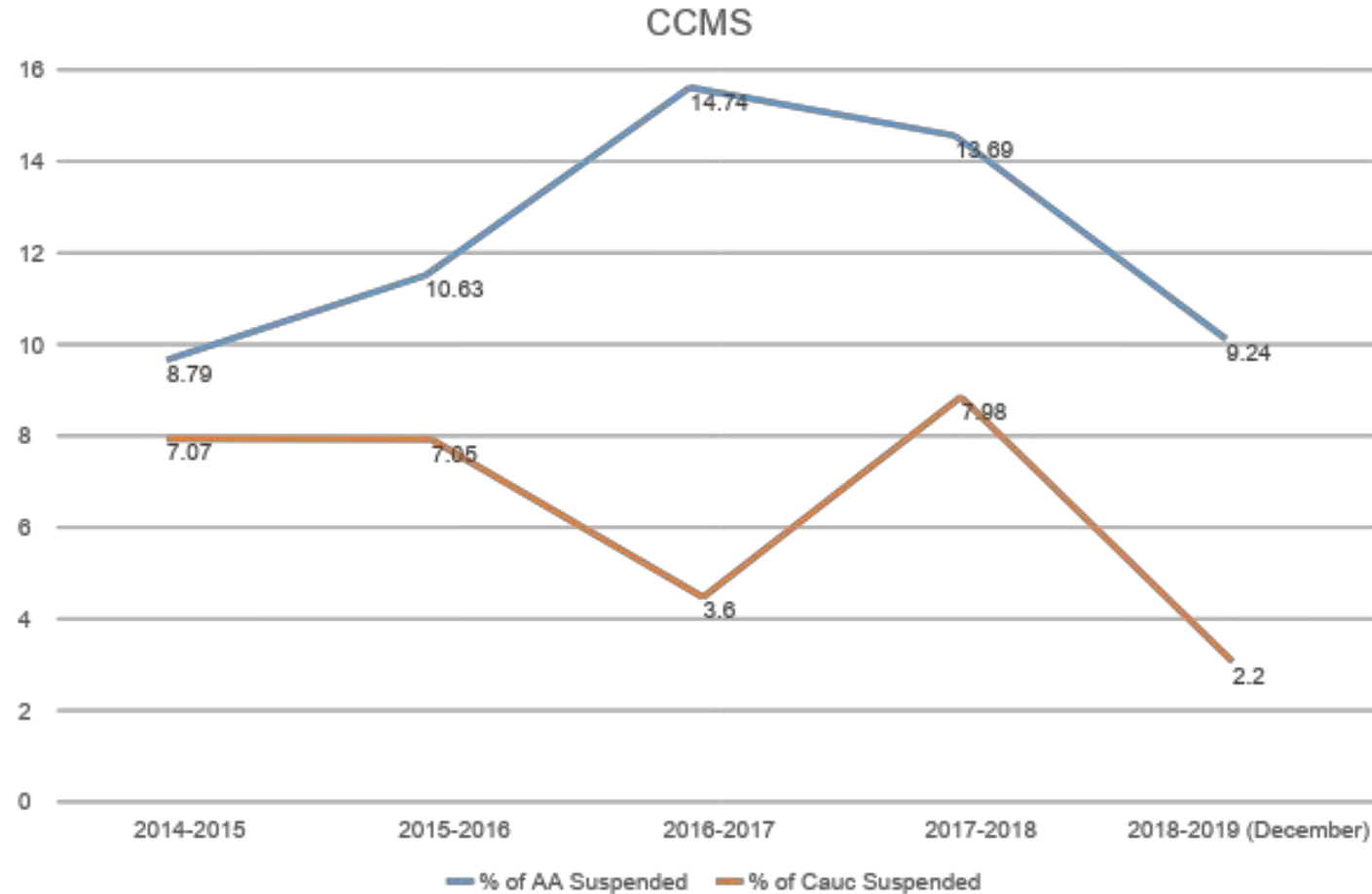


# Out of School Suspension - Hopkinsville High School

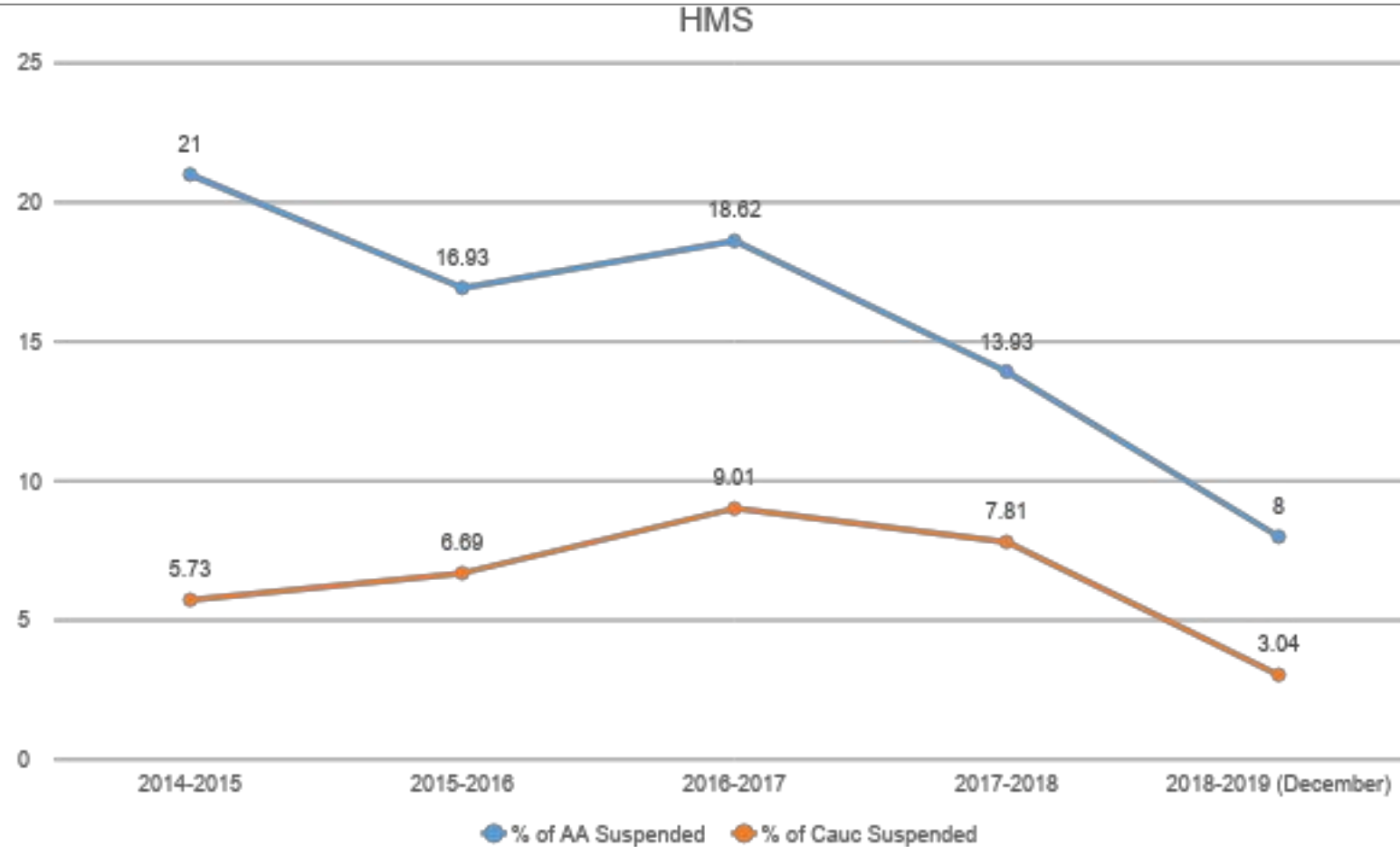

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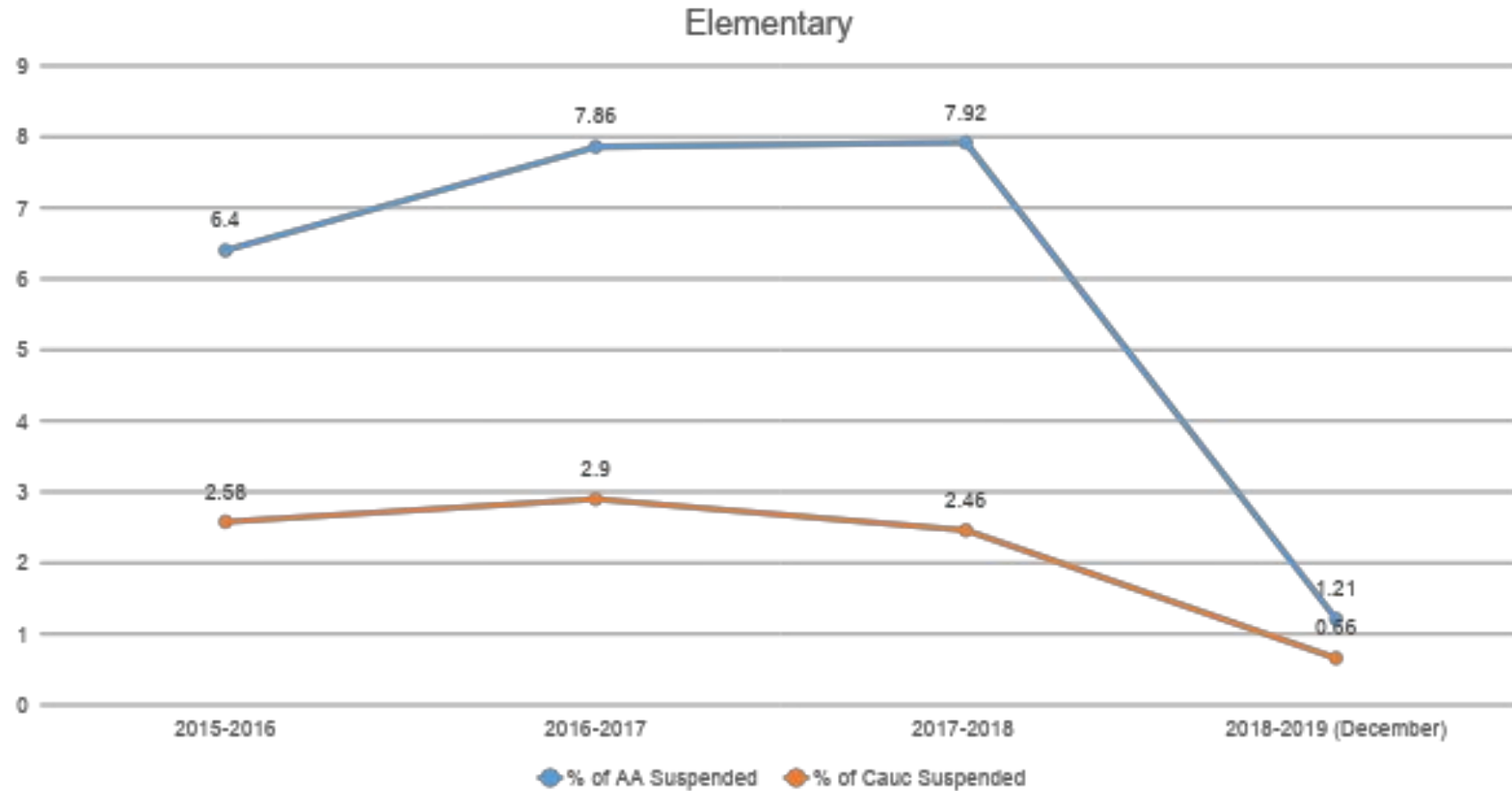

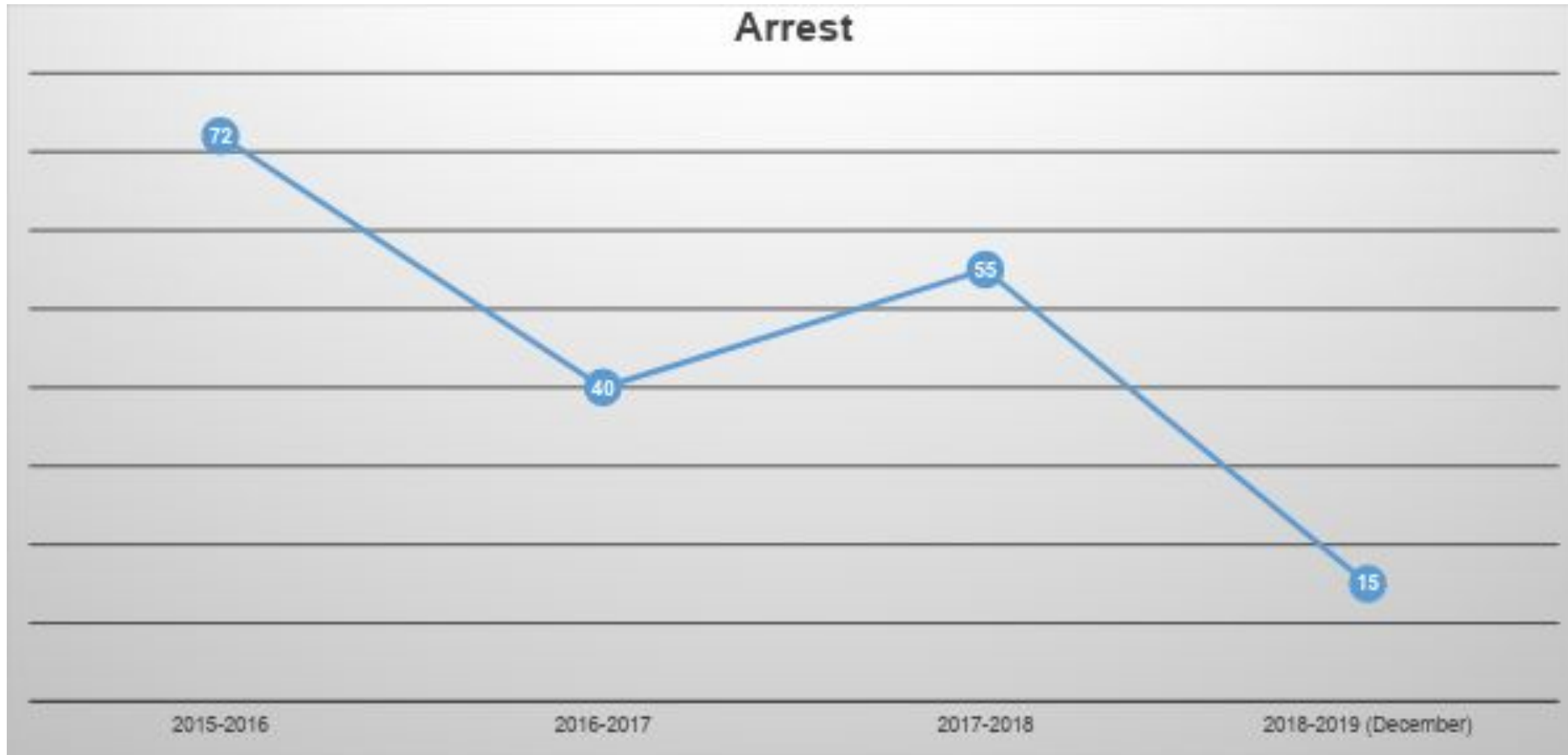
