Honorable Jay A. Wethington, Chief Circuit Judge, 6th Judicial Circuit administered the Oath of Office to the Board of Commissioners.

6.A. ELECTION OF MAYOR PRO TEM

This was the first meeting of a new term for Commissioners Larry Maglinger (who received 7,962 votes in the November election), Pam Smith-Wright (who received 7,254 votes), Larry Conder (who received 6,787 votes); and Jeff Sanford (who received 6,556 votes).

Traditionally, the honor of Mayor Pro Tem goes to the Commissioner who received the most votes in the general election. In keeping with tradition, Larry Maglinger was elected Mayor Pro Tem on motion of Mayor Tom Watson, seconded by Commissioner Smith-Wright. Motion carried 5-0. The Mayor Pro Tem fills in when the Mayor is out of town or otherwise unavailable.

Mayor Watson and each of the Commissioners recognized their family and friends in attendance and expressed their enthusiasm to serve the citizens of Owensboro.
