This is being sent to all member schools in the Basketball 15th Region, including Principals, Superintendents, and Athletic Directors. Because this is being sent via electronic script, it is likely that direct replies to this message will not be received by the author.

Good day to each of you.

Please consider this as notice of planned action. More than two years ago, the Board of Control approved the 15th region trying an experiment with the format of the regional tournament in basketball, baseball, softball, and volleyball. At that point, school administrators were invited to meet to discuss the parameters of the plan, and multiple meetings were held.

For a variety of reasons, the plan to attempt an alternative format did not materialize. Once discussions got down to the logistics of scheduling, ranking, etc., there was no consensus on a workable plan to move forward.

Since no plan has been recommended by the schools, it will be my recommendation to the Board of Control that the experiment is sunset effective with the Board's January meeting. This will mean that if there is a desire in the future for such an experiment, it will need to be reintroduced to the Board of Control. It will be my recommendation that until the logistical details are presented in full, including scheduling and ranking alternatives, that it not be considered.

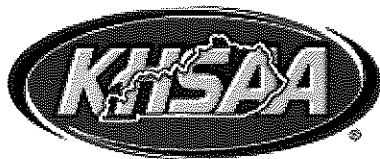
Both the Board of Control and our staff are always supportive of membership initiatives and welcome the opportunity for further discussion in the future if such is desired.

We do not poll coaches, sportswriters, or fans. Nor does our staff make any judgments on the merits of any individual team. Prior season history, school size, and comments on message boards are not considered in the MaxPreps Computer Rankings.

The system utilizes the huge number of game results stored in the MaxPreps database. Generally, the more a team wins the higher the ranking, but the system takes into account quality wins (against other highly ranked opponents) and strength of schedule.

For example, a team's ranking is hurt more by losing to a team that is ranked below them verses a team ranked ahead.

Other factors that will affect the rankings are times when MaxPreps has incomplete or inaccurate information. We will correct errors when they are reported to us. If we are missing a score, report it to us on the team's MaxPreps page. If we are missing a game on the schedule, send us a correction request.

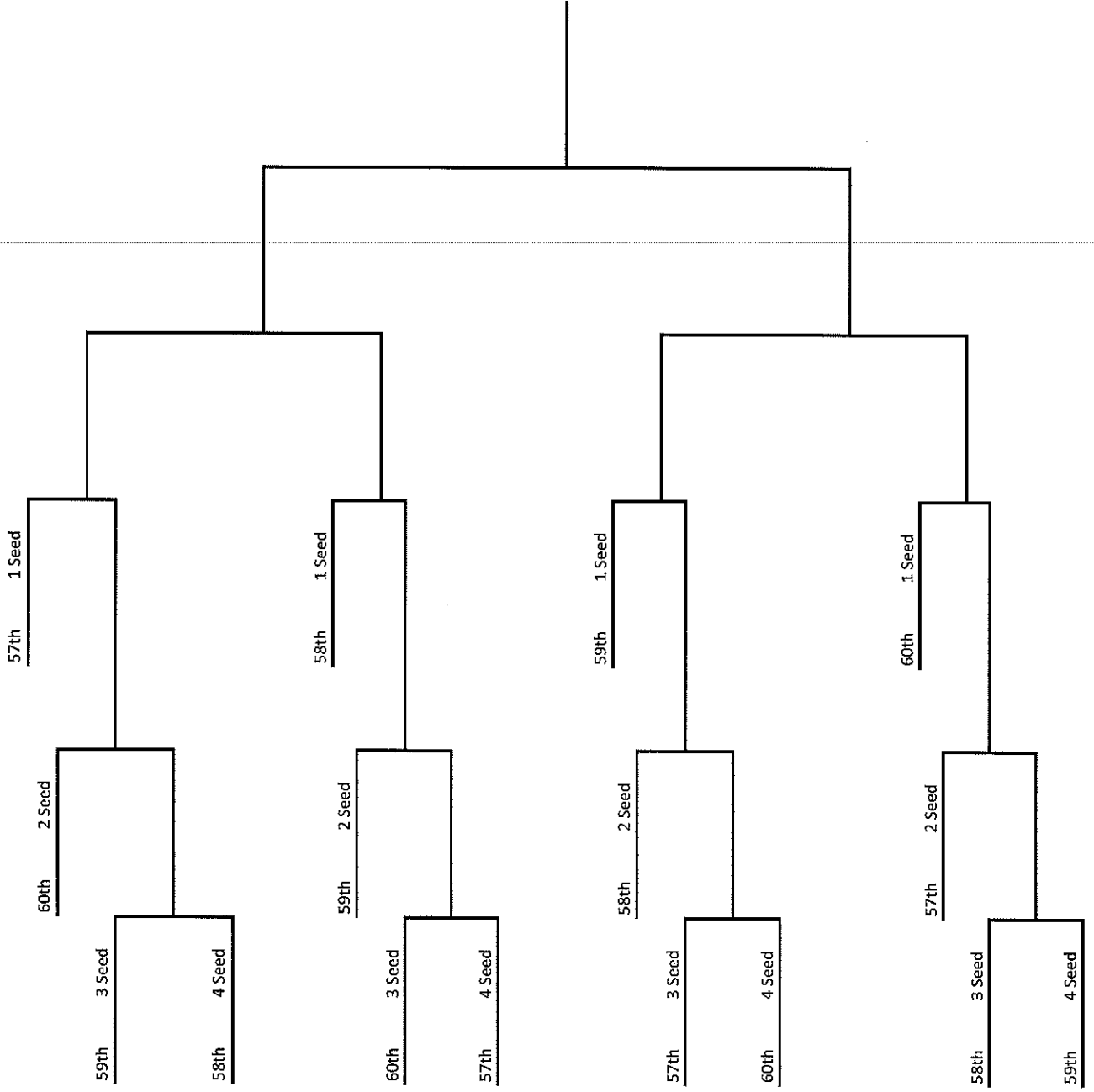

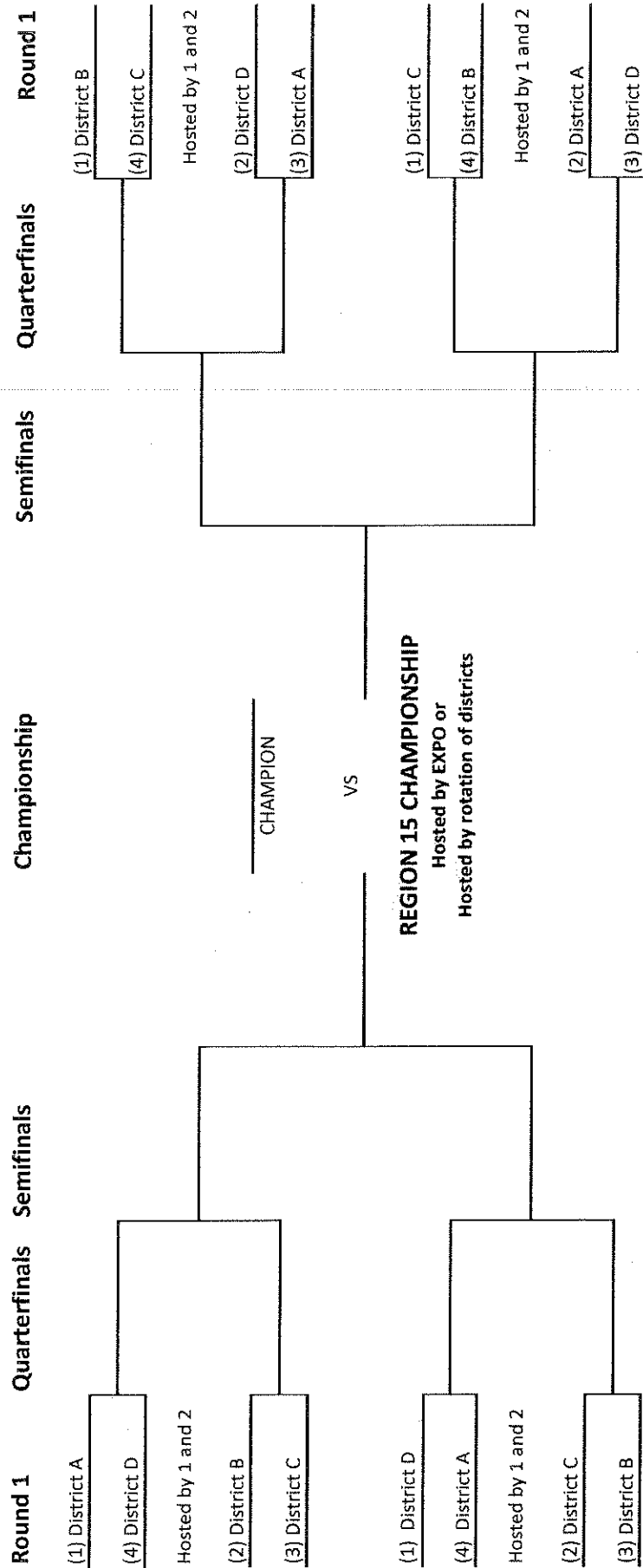

Benefits of 15/16 Team Super Regional

- 1.) Easier Scheduling – Every team in the region will play every other team in the 15th region at least 1 time. This will generate 14-15 games to our regular season schedule (So many Home/So many Away each year) and cut down on travel costs as half of our schedule will be played in region.
- 2.) Regional Records can be easily tracked and used for seeding purposes.
- 3.) If everyone is not in agreement that all regional teams play, then the Super Regional can still be played using the District tournaments as a guide for seeding.
- 4.) Every Regional game, and district tournament (including consolation games) will be meaningful
 - a. District Champions will get double bye (seeds 1-4)
 - b. District Runners Up will get single bye (seeds 5-8)
 - c. Consolation Winners will be seeds 9-12
 - d. Fourth Place teams will be seeds 13-16
 - e. Spot placement on the bracket can be determined by drawing pills.
 - f. 2 way ties will be broken using head to head format...3 or more ties use pill draw
- 5.) Increased Revenue
 - a. Keep District Tournaments and Add Consolation Games
 - b. Increase the overall number of teams in the Regional Tournament and overall number of Regional Tournament Games
 - c. Allow first round regional games to be played at host sites (higher seed) where the host school will keep concession sales.
- 6.) Revenue Split
 - a. Teams involved in 1st Round and 2nd Round Regional Tournament games can split gate/ticket sales with each other. In other words, 8 schools will receive profit sharing from the gates of these games.
 - b. 3rd Round and beyond will involve 8 schools as well. Those schools can share profits as well with each other.
 - c. All 16 schools will receive some type of revenue (We already share with all schools anyway)
- 7.) Every team will actually participate in the regional tournament
- 8.) District Games played Monday – Thursday of District Week (Host Sites) (Friday Makeup Date)
- 9.) 1st Round Regional Games – Saturday (Host Sites)
- 10.) 2nd Round Regional Games – Monday – Thursday of Regional Week (Host Sites)
- 11.) 3rd Round Regional Games – Tuesday – following Tuesday (Final 8 teams at Expo Center)
