ART ROOM LOCATION - Waiver Request per KAR 4:160


Dear Mr. Dunbar:

Pursuant to your Design Development review letter, dated November 9, 2018, and referenced comment 1b, we are requesting a waiver in accordance with 701 KAR 4:160 for the art room location requirement with the following justifications.

1. During the early stages of design, we requested that the architect position the special instructional program spaces remotely from each other, and across both floors of the buildings. Doing so will alleviate student congestion traveling throughout the hallways when compared to placing all of the special program spaces on one level.
2. Locating the Art Room on the second floor allows the entire student population to experience both floors of the facility. Otherwise, many primary grade students would not have an opportunity to be taught on the second floor.
3. The location of the Art Room takes advantage of a tall structural location, and allows for an interesting and creative learning environment suitable for art instruction, as shown on the attached rendering. This opportunity cannot be easily replicated on the first floor level.
4. The Art Room still faces north as required by regulation.
5. A north facing outdoor classroom (art-patio) has been included in the design as well and is included in the bid documents as an Alternate.
