Teachers and administrators will use this MAP data along with our Winter CASE assessment data to help determine individual student needs and to enhance our instructional practices.

During our primary and intermediate assemblies, students were recognized in a multitude of different areas for their hard work: perfect attendance, sight word mastery (primary), meeting AR goals, and honor roll (intermediate) are just a few.
