








# Percentage of Students Meeting MAP Growth Benchmarks (Fall to Winter)

# **Backpack League**



#### **District Sponsored Programming**

- Targeting those students needing support in reading and math
- Inviting 5,000 students entering grades 3-6 in 2019-2020
- Powerful learning experiences designed and delivered by teachers

#### **Community Sponsored Programming**

- Targeting those students needing support in reading and math
- Community partner groups will have the services of a math and reading teacher each day
- Minimum commitment of 75 minutes of instruction in each subject area each day
- No cost to the community partner groups










# Status Update - % CAP Actions Established

# Early Childhood – Improvement Strategies

- Partner with Head Start agency to expand services to students
- Continue to implement
  Kindergarten Readiness Camp
- Review and refine procedures in facilities, health, safety and student information\*
- Collaborate with KDE on classroom walkthroughs and leadership meetings\*



\*Progress Update – 5 CAP actions: 4 developing and 1 established

# Early Childhood – Outcome Data

- Overall, 52.5% of students were kindergarten ready
- 60.5% of JCPS students in state funded preschool were kindergarten ready
- 71% of JCPS students who participate in Kindergarten Readiness
  Camp were ready
- 503 walkthroughs conducted in 18-19 school year
- 632 staff participating in PD during the 18-19 school year



# Personnel Management – Improvement Strategies

- Re-organize Human Resources to better support schools
- Partner with local universities and colleges to improve minority teacher recruitment
- Implement new leadership development model
- Reduce central office expenditures and redirect to schools
- Develop monitoring processes for continuous improvement\*
- Implement two way communication systems to support employees\*

# Personal Management – Outcome Data

- Established Leadership Development cohorts
- 50% of all administrators hired this school year are people of color
- Over 4,000 staff participated in Racial Equity Institute to date
- 10% of job descriptions reviewed to date
- Over 800 employee files reviewed and cleaned to date
