Special Education/Preschool Report

1. Born Learning Academy meets for the fourth time on Tuesday, February 12th. We are expecting another good turn out!
2. The Little Cub School met on Friday, February 8th. We had 5 children and their parents participate in the 1 hour program. We were missing 4 families due to illness.
3. Monday night was Preschool Bowling Night! This is the culminating activity as Mrs. Smith put a bowling station in the classroom for January. They are excited to put their new skills to work as they order shoes, purchase concessions and knock down those pins!
4. The Civil Rights Data Collection site opened this month and is due in 6 weeks. I have been gathering data to enter into the data base.
5. This is the year Southgate preschool undergoes ECERS evaluation (Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale). I have been completing the self-evaluation. KDE will come in early March to also evaluate. I am anticipating a good report.
