- Our fifth grade students will be enjoying for their annual overnight trip to Camp Joy on Feb. 20th through Feb. 22nd. They raised the needed \$12,000 for the trip through fundraisers, business donations, staff donations, etc. During the three-day trip, the students will participate in cultural history activities, adventure activities (ie. high ropes courses), and a living history reenactment (The Underground Railroad). We are grateful for the hard work of staff members for making this trip possible for our students.
- Our little devils continue to impress us with their reading performance on the Accelerated Reader program. So far this year the students have read over 19,500 books and successfully taken their AR quizzes. This number is up over 5,000 books from last school year at this time. Our school-wide goal for this 18-19 school year is 30,000.
- Our annual World's Finest Chocolate candy Bar Sale has raised approximately \$5,000 for the student activity fund.
- Our students continue to have opportunities to participate in regional/state-wide events:

 - Queen City Chess Tournament – March 16th – Chess Club Members
- Grade level teams (primary) and Content Teams (intermediate) continue ongoing curriculum work - CASE Analysis, Live Scoring, Curriculum document revision, Analyzing student work, etc. These on-going comprehensive and collaborative conversations and work are leading to our increased knowledge of individual student progress.
