STUDENTS 09.1221

Shortened School Day and/or Week Part-Time Students

The Board shall will-consider a shortened school day only for preschool and kindergarten students and a shortened school day and/or week only for students with an Individual Education Program (IEP)individual education plan or Section 504 Plan plan-that supports a shortened day.

The recommendation to the Board for a shortened school day and/or week shall be based on the following:

- 1. Minutes of the Admissions and Release Committee (ARC) meeting documenting the ARC decision that a shortened school day and/or week is needed;
- An IEP or Section 504 Plan that prescribes the length of the shortened school day and/or week; and
- A written statement from the student's physician stating the need for a shortened school day and/or week.

Student confidentiality procedures shall be followed when listing student information in the Board meeting agenda and minutes.

Following approval by the Board, the District shall submit to the Kentucky Department of Education all information the Department requires in the form and manner established by the Department, including, but not limited to student directory information and all information upon which the determination for a shortened school day or week was based, as set forth in this policy.
