Lesson Plan:

The students will be performing their summative assessment at North Oldham High School for KMEA Festival. This will give the students a chance to make connections to the community around them outside of the school itself by seeing other performance activities and other school groups perform. This will also be a performance opportunity for the entire group in which they will be covering multiple standards on the national level. They will make observations and reflections on this performance and the performances of other bands that day and also when the judges tapes come in. This will help our students understand what a professional performance is like and they will receive a professional evaluation along with having an opportunity to perform at a high level.

Learning Target: I can: develop and refine artistic work for presentation.

National Standards:

Anchor #4: Analyze, interpret, and select artistic work for presentation. All of my students have worked together on these pieces and the students themselves have chosen these pieces together with the director and discussed each piece in depth. The selection, interpretation, and performance of these pieces meets this standard and also goes a long way into developing their skills as an independent musician.
