Here is the information you requested regarding our trip to Nationals:

We are leaving Louisville airport on Thursday, February 27th at 3:47 PM on Allegiant air, flying into Orlando Sanford Airport.

We will be returning on a Frontier Flight from Orlando (MCO) at 10:55 on Sunday, March 3rd. We will arrive in Louisville at 1:05 on Sunday.
