AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF MOREHEAD, KENTUCKY CODE OF ORDINANCES, TITLE 3, ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 34, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, (RECREATIONAL, TOURIST, AND CONVENTION COMMISSION) SECTION 34.43 TRANSIENT ROOM TAX, OF THE CITY OF MOREHEAD CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE THAT SHORT TERM RENTALS ARE SUBJECT TO THE TRANSIENT ROOM TAX

WHEREAS, the City of Morehead collects a transient room tax and desires that said tax apply to short term rentals such as those operated by Airbnb;

WHEREAS, Airbnb after lengthy discussions with Kentucky Travel Industry Association acknowledged that local transient room tax was applicable to their operations;

WHEREAS, in order to collect said tax, the current ordinance must be amended;

WHEREAS, the Morehead Recreational, Tourist and Convention commission has requested that the board of City Council amend their ordinance in accordance with the recommendation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of City Council of the City of Morehead, Kentucky that Title 3, Administration, Chapter 34, Boards and Commissions, (Recreational, Tourist and Convention Commission) Section 34.43 Transient Room Tax be amended as follows:

34.43 Transient Room Tax

- (A) For the purpose of the operation of the Morehead Recreational, Tourist and Convention Commission, there is imposed and levied a transient room tax of three percent (3 %) of the gross rent for every occupancy of a suite, room, or rooms charged by all persons, companies, corporations and other like or similar persons, groups, or organizations doing business as motor courts, motels, hotels, inns, or like or similar accommodations businesses in the city.
- (B) In addition to the above three percent (3%), there is imposed and levied a special transient room tax of one percent (1%) of the gross rents for every occupancy of a suite, room, or rooms charged by all persons, companies, corporations, and other like or similar persons, groups or organizations doing business as motor courts, motels, hotels, inns or like or similar accommodations businesses in the city. This additional one percent (1%) transient room tax is levied for the sole purpose of meeting the operating expenses of the Morehead Conference Center.

(C) Short Term Rentals
