Memorandum of Agreement  
Between  
Campbellsville University School of Education  
And  
Marion County Schools

The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement between the Campbellsville University School of Education and Marion County Schools is to provide Marion County Curriculum Coaches with the knowledge and skills necessary to lead in the instruction, assessment, and career and transitional needs of students identified as gifted and talented in the Marion County School District.

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) dated February 14, 2019 between the Marion County School District and Campbellsville University School of Education hereby contains the following provisions:

- Campbellsville University will provide the 12 credit hour online Gifted and Talented Endorsement Program at a reduced rate for a minimum of five Marion County curriculum coaches. Marion County will pay \$750.00 per three hour course for each candidate. They will pay \$250.00 per one hour practicum for each candidate. They will pay a \$75.00 technology fee for three terms for each candidate.
- Marion County Schools will provide access to classes with students identified as Gifted and Talented, cumulative records of students identified as Gifted and Talented, and structured field experiences with students identified as Gifted and Talented.
- At the conclusion of the 12 credit hour program, participating teachers will take the Praxis exam for licensure and will complete all necessary paperwork to have the Gifted and Talented Endorsement added to their certificate.
