Dear Franklin Simpson Education Excellence Foundation Board ,

Simpson Elementary is in need of a 5000 lumen projector for multi-purpose use. The goal of procuring this projector is to enhance our student performances (6 musicals a year), leadership assemblies that take place monthly for each grade, and enhancing the presentations of our community events such as the Veterans day assembly, making them even more honorable with clarity and definition for all those in attendance. To achieve these desired outcomes, we have been using a projector that is a few years old but the lumens aren't powerful enough to cast the image on the screen without turning out the lights entirely. This makes it difficult to recognize and honor students in front of their peers in a pitch-black gym.

In evaluation of this project we have assessed that a 5000 lumen projector would meet our desired needs. To enhance the visual quality of all our events and allow the lights to be on so we can provide recognition to those being honored or celebrated. Scot Perdue the district technology coordinator brought in two different companies to provide quotes for this project to get their opinions as well. Both companies recommend mounting the projector to the trusses in the ceiling so it is readily available at any time. The projector would have a protective frame around it to protect it from an errant ball or object that may travel in it's direction.

Attached, you can see two quotes that we have received to purchase and install this equipment. The first bid is from Pomeroy for \$10,960 and the other is from Creative-Image
